# Series "Jesus Is Better" "Haters Of The Word" Hebrews 10:26-31 Study-22

We come to the "4th" of the "5 Problem Passages In Hebrews":

- 1. Drifting from the Word 2:1-4 (Neglect)
- 2. Doubting the Word 3:7-4:13 (Hard Heart)
- 3. Dullness toward the Word 5:11-6:20 (Sluggishness)
- 4. Despising the Word 10:26-39 (Willfulness)

Verses 26-31 – A Warning To Avoid God's Judgment Verses 32-39 – Commending All Who Persevere

The Thought Of Our Passage: "Willful Sin, In Full Knowledge Of The Truth, Must Be Judged By The God Of Mercy And Righteousness."

- 1. Verses 26-27 The Sin That Brings Judgment
- 2. Verses 28-29 The Rationale Of Judgment
- 3. Verses 30-31 The Terror Of Judgment

## 1. Verses 26-27 - The Sin That Brings Judgment:

Hebrews 10:26

"For" – joins the previous 3 commands in Hebrews 10:22-25 with the warning of possible judgment:

- 1. Verse 22 Let Us Draw Near In Our Personal Devotion In (Faith).
- 2. Verse 23 Let Us Hold Fast In Our Consistency In (Hope).
- 3. Verses 24-25 Let Us Consider Our Social Obligation In (Love).

"if we" – Note that the author places himself along with his readers.

"willfully" – "deliberately, and continually"; It is proverbially "first degree sin"; The person that persists in open rebellion against God and His Word.

1 Peter 5:2

"receiving" – carries the idea "receiving something with full knowledge, an experience"; we would say "signing for a package."

"truth" – "body of doctrine; the essential truths that all genuine followers of Jesus hold to."

Hebrews 6:4-6

Hebrews 10:27

"terrifying" – fearful, dreadful; used 3X in the NT, Hebrews 10:27, 31;12:21. Each time the word is used as referring to meeting God.

OT made a distinction between sins committed <u>Unintentionally</u> and those committed <u>Intentionally</u>. Numbers 15:30-31

King David knew defiant sin was not covered. 1 Chronicles 21:13

When Christians sin, they can be restored. Our High Priest will help us – Hebrews 2:17-18.

Galatians 6:1

1 John 2:1-2

# 2. Verses 28-29 - The Rationale Of Judgment:

Hebrews 10:28

"Anyone who has set aside the Law of Moses" – The term "set aside" – "to render null and void."

Deuteronomy 17:2-7

Hebrews 10:29

How much severer - "worse"

"Punishment" – "penalty, vengeance"

What Is The Punishment? Severe chastisement by the hand of God upon the child of God in this life. The loss of reward at the judgment seat of Christ.

Acts 5:1-11 – "Ananias, with his wife Sapphira."

1 Corinthians 3:13-15

1 Corinthians 11:29-32

A violator of the old covenant suffered at the hands of men, but a rebel under the new covenant will be dealt with directly by God – Hebrews 10:30-31.

### The writer mentions 3 offenses of willful rebellion:

1<sup>st</sup> Offense Of Trampling The Son Of God: "who has trampled under foot the Son of God," – (Person) Matthew 5:13.

Matthew 7:6

Luke 8:5

"trampled under foot the Son of God," – "grinding Him into the dirt." Turning away from Jesus is an attack on His person; "to reject, neglect and disregard the Christian position, but includes antagonism."

**2<sup>nd</sup> Offense Of Profaning The Blood:** "and has regarded as unclean the blood of the covenant" – (His Work) the word "unclean": "an unholy thing, common thing"; to treat Jesus' blood like any other man's blood, and this insults the God of heaven.

"was sanctified" – forever set apart from the world unto God, 1 Corinthians 6:11.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Offense Of Insulting The Holy Spirit:** "and has insulted the Spirit of grace?" – (Person & Work Of The Holy Spirit); The word "insulted": "outrage, rudeness, arrogant rejection of the grace of God through the Holy Spirit."

Ephesians 4:30

"Spirit of grace" – only time the Holy Spirit is called this NT, Zechariah 12:10.

Hebrews 6 talks about backsliding. Here it describes this willful persistent ongoing rebellion.

Hebrews 3:12; Hebrews 4:1; Hebrews 4:11

### 3. Verses 30-31 – The Terror Of Judgment:

Hebrews 10:30

"VENGEANCE IS MINE, I WILL REPAY." - Deuteronomy 32:35

Deuteronomy 32:35-36 – This passage is taken from Moses' farewell speech.

Romans 12:19

"And again, 'THE LORD WILL JUDGE HIS PEOPLE." – Deuteronomy 32:36.

Psalm 135:14

Jeremiah 7:3-4

"His people" – this judgment is not the eternal punishment of the lost, but rather the chastisement of erring children within the covenant.

Hebrews 10:31 – "terrifying" – "fearful, frightful, dreadful"

Philippians 2:12

Acts 5:10-11

1 Peter 5:6

Matthew 10:28; Ezekiel 33:11

- 1. A Theme Of Hebrews Is "God Has Spoken." How Are We Responding To His Word?
- 2. OT Israel Perished In The Wilderness; NT The Child Of God Shall Perish In The Wilderness Of Lost Opportunity.
