"His Indescribable Gift" 2 Corinthians 9:15 Sunday Morning, December 22, 2013

2 Cor 9:15 – "Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!"

"indescribable" – The Greek word can be translated "unspeakable, or inexpressible". This particular Greek word appears only here in the N.T. "It describes something hard to describe in human language; that which cannot be fully declared."

How Can A Gift Be Indescribable?

The Context Of Our Passage: 2 Corinthians 9

Then Paul shifts his attention from human gifts to God's gift of sending Jesus to earth for us. And Paul cannot find words to describe that. He simply says, "Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift."

Every gift that human beings can give is "describable." The only gift that can be called "indescribable is that which is more than human." It is something of God mixed into it.

Why Does Paul Refer To Jesus As "The Indescribable Gift?" <u>4 reasons</u> for Jesus being called "The Indescribable Gift":

1. Indescribable – Jesus Is God With Us:

2 Cor 9:15 – "Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!"

The Nature Of The Gift: The gift is God's Son.

Who Is Jesus? Jesus said He was one with the Father. How do you describe a baby born of a virgin? How do you describe God in flesh, walking upon our earth & reaching out to the hurting masses of humanity?

Isaiah said He would be called **Emanuel**, "God with us." How do you describe that? What words would you choose?

2. Indescribable – What God Did For Us:

2 Cor 9:15 – "Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!"

Paul called Jesus indescribable because of His purpose in coming to earth. The angels announced to the shepherds, Luke 2:11

What Do We Celebrate At Christmas? We celebrate the fact that Jesus came into our world to save us. God saw that mankind needed saving.

3. Indescribable – The Grace Given To Us:

2 Cor 9:15 – "Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!"

That is what makes God's gift so special. He doesn't owe us anything.

- 2. The Message Of Christmas The Depths Of Human Sin Were So Great That God Intervened By Sending His Only Son Jesus, To Die For Us So That We Could Be Made Right Before God.
- 3. The Message Of Christmas The Savior Was Born Because Man Is A Sinner In Need Of A Savior. Jesus Alone Can Forgive Sins And Give Salvation: Acts 4:12.
- The Message Of Christmas If I Will Repent (Turn From My Sins), And Believe In Jesus Christ (The Savior), I Will Receive The Greatest Gift Of All, Jesus, Our Salvation: Romans 10:9-10.
