Eph. 5:18-21 – Is A Section Dealing With "Walking in the Spirit"

Being filled with the Holy Spirit – simply means "to be controlled by or yielded to the Holy Spirit"

#### Paul Gives 3 Evidences For Being Spirit Filled:

- 1. Joy Eph. 5:19
  - 1) Joy in the heart, 2) towards others and 3) the Lord.
- 2. Thankfulness Eph. 5:20

1 Thess. 5:18

3. Submission – Eph. 5:21

The word "subject" – A Greek military term meaning "to arrange in troop divisions in a military fashion under the command of a leader"; In a non-military usage, it is "a voluntary attitude of giving in, cooperating, assuming responsibility, and carrying a burden."

# Eph. 5:22-24 - Wives Submit To The Lord:

# 1. Verse 22 – Wives' Submission – Is Voluntary:

Eph. 5:22

Eph. 5:25-33 – Husbands submit to the Lord by loving their wives.

Eph. 6:1-3 – Children submit to the Lord through obedience to Parents.

Eph. 6:4 – Fathers submit to the Lord through not provoking their children.

Eph. 6:5-8 – Employees submit to the Lord through obeying their Employers.

Eph. 6:9 – Employers submit to the Lord through not threatening.

"Subject" - A Greek military term meaning "to arrange troop divisions"

An appeal to the Christian wives to place themselves under God's order. (Submission – "Allowing God To Lead Me Through Others.")

#### 2. Verse 22 - Wives' Submission - As To The Lord:

Eph. 5:22

- 1. After a woman is married, the only way that she can fully submit to God is to submit to her husband. (It becomes God's will for their life.) Rom. 13:2
- 2. Because the wife submits to the Lord, she is able to submit to the husband.

## 3. Verse 23 – Wives' Submission – To Your Husband:

Eph. 5:23

"head of the church," - "the position or state of being a leader, in command"

"Savior" - "deliverer, preserver"

1 Sam 25 - Abigail and Nabal

4. Verse 24 – Wives' Submission – In Everything:

Eph. 5:24

"But as the church is subject to Christ," – Eph 5:23: Jesus is the head and the Savior.

"so also the wives ought to be to their husbands in everything."

- 1. Husband oversteps when he... Forbids what God commands.
- 2. Husband oversteps when he... Commands what God forbids.

#### Eph. 5:25-33 – Husbands submitting to the Lord:

## 1. Verse 25 – "Husbands" – A Love That Sacrifices:

Eph. 5:25

v.25 - "love your wives"

v.28 – "so husbands ought also to love their own wives"

v.33 - "let each individual among you also love his own wife."

#### In the Greek language there are four words for love.

- 1. Eros not used in the Bible. Sexual love Eros erotic it's a receiving love, not giving.
- 2. Storgee not used in the Bible. Family love/parental.
- 3. Phileo Human Iove. Affection brotherly Iove affection human Iove.
- 4. Agape God's Divine love "Unconditional, choice, commitment, to love, a love that exists to demonstrate, not based on performance, but a deliberate choice made without assignable cause save that which lies in the nature of God Himself"

A Husband's Love Is Not Dependent Upon A Wife's Performance – Colossians 3:19

#### What To Do!

- 1. If you are not a believer, you need to receive Jesus Christ:
- 2. Be Filled With the Spirit:

Yield – present yourself to God – yield to the Word

- 3. Commit Yourself to Love Obey His command
- 4. Love Sacrificially

# 2. Verses 26-27 - Husband's - Love That Cleanses:

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Eph. 5:26
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"sanctify" - "to set apart, to be holy, sacred, special use"

"word" – It is speaking about, "the spoken word."

Eph. 5:27

"having no spot" – caused by defilement on the outside.

"or wrinkle" – caused by decay, this comes from the inside.

2 Cor. 3:18

# 3. Verses 28-30 – "Husbands" – Love For His Wife Should Mirror The Love For Himself: Eph. 5:28

"ought" – "owe, to be a debtor"; not emotion, we owe a debt to her to love.

Eph. 5:29

"but nourishes" – to feed, physically – provide for ....

1 Tim. 5:8

"cherishes it" - "to soften or warm with body heat" (Bird to keep young warm)

Eph. 5:30

#### 4. Verses 31-33 – Husband's – Love Endures To The End:

Eph. 5:31

# 3 things that speak of stability.

- 1. (Severance) "For this cause a man shall <u>leave</u> his father and mother,"
- 2. (Permanence) "shall cleave to his wife;"
- 3. (Unity) "and the two shall be one flesh"

Eph. 5:32-33
