Introduction to The Minor Prophets Hosea- Malachi

As Jeremiah's message was to Judah's last hours, so the message of Hosea was to Israel in her last hours.

The Minor Prophets cover a period of 400 years.

- 1. Hosea, Amos, and Micah Speak of the fall of Israel (Samaria) and of the overthrow that already threatened Judah.
- 2. Obadiah, Jonah and Nahum who prophesy against certain Gentile nations; mainly Edom and Nineveh.
- 3. Haggai, Zechariah, and Malachi, who were post-captivity prophets, the first two dealing with the restored exiles, and the last bearing witness to the failure of the people and the coming of the Messiah and His forerunner.
- 4. Joel, Habakkuk, and Zephaniah, have a peculiar character such that it marks them off from the rest. They speak of the end, the closing scenes, and the great crisis toward which the world is fast hastening.

- 2. Prophetical
- 3. Practical
