## 1. Defining Genuine Worship:

Ecclesiastes 3:11

What Worship Is Not!

· Worship is not AN EVENT.

Matthew 15:8

- · Worship is not MUSIC.
- · Worship is not A PERFORMANCE.
- · Worship is not A FEELING.
- · Worship is not something that is CONFINED to one day a week.

The word Worship comes from the old English "worth-ship" which means, "to ascribe worth or value to something or someone."

True Worship – Hebrew – 4 words "to bow down, to do homage" Greek – "to kiss towards" Another word is "a priestly ministry" Take the Hebrew and Greek words put them together and you get attitudes (awe, reverence, respect) and actions (bowing, praising, serving) Subjective and objective.

Worship - is "the believers response of all that they are-mind, emotions, will, and body-to what God is and says and does."

True worship - is "to attribute worth to a real Being, one who is truly there and who is truly worthy."

True Worship Is Corporate Worship: Psalm 95:1-6

False worship - "to attribute worth to an illusion which is not really there, or which is not worthy."

True Worship - is a response to who God is.

True Praise - is a response to what God does.

Ephesians 5:18

What does it mean to be filled with the Holy Spirit?

It speaks of 4 things.

- 1. "Filled" is in the Greek imperative mode which means "it's is a command."
- 1 Corinthians 3:1-3
- 2. Plural "it is meant for all Christians."
- 3. Passive verb "The Spirit does it."
- 4. Present tense "Keep on being filled."

Being filled with the Holy Spirit means – "that one is controlled by, or yielded to the Holy Spirit."

Evidence of being filled with the Holy Spirit.

3. Submission - subject - A Greek military term meaning "to arrange [troop divisions] in a military fashion under the command of a leader." In non-military use, it was "a voluntary attitude of giving in, cooperating, assuming responsibility, and carrying a burden."
