Tradition - "what is handed down"

This term "Tradition" can go two different ways:

- 1. Tradition is referred to as Scripture that was handed down:
 - 1 Corinthians 11:2
 - 2 Thessalonians 2:15
- 2. Tradition is Man's Opinion that was handed down:

The Jews called Tradition - "The Fence of The Law."

1. Those of False Tradition Are Fault-finders - For they (Disciples) do not wash their hands when they eat bread."
