Matthew 8:26-27

(Numbers 32, Joshua 1)

two men who were demon-possessed met Him The gospel of **Matthew** says that there were two men from the tombs. **Mark** and **Luke** mention just one man.

demon-possessed We use the term "Possessed." Occurs thirteen times in the New Testament, all in the Gospels The most accurate term would be "Demonization or Demonized." It is under the influence of one or more evil spirits.

Matthew 8:16

The Bible does not teach that a Christian can be Demonized.

1 John 4:4

Matthew 12:43-45

- 1. **Physical problems –** Super strength, violent.
- 2. Mental Insanity- Definitely the case here.
- 3. **Spiritual -** Corruption of the truth through false religion

Demonic Activity Is Associated with Death: as they were coming out of the tombs;

Ephesians 2:1-3

Demonic Activity Is Associated with Physical problems they were so exceedingly violent We see this man was literally "a violent or beyond description savage"

Luke 8:27

The Evidence of Demonic activity is being unclean: Luke 8:29

unclean spirit – speaks of moral and physical uncleanness, involved in vices, things that the Bible speaks clearly against.

Mark 5:5

Self is Powerless: gashing himself with stones.

2. The Demons Acknowledge Jesus as the Ultimate Judge: Have You come here to torment us before the time?"

False views of judgment:

- 1. There will be no final judgment: Genesis 3:4
- 2. If there is a final judgment I will be spared:

- 3. I have not done anything serious enough to merit judgment. Romans 3:23

- 4. If I have earned judgment God is to kind to allow me to be punished: Romans 6:23
- 5. If I am sent to judgment the place is really quite pleasant:

Mark 5:9

3. The Demons Believe Jesus Has Ultimate Authority: "If You are going to cast us out, send us into the herd of swine."
