Resurrection – "act of rising from the dead, to rise again, to live again." Not another body, or spiritualizing, but a physical returning back to the body.

On that day - The day is Tuesday of the Passion Week. Tuesday is referred to as "The Day of Controversy"

Sadducees –

Deut 7:6-8

1. Sadducees did not believe in the resurrection
2. Sadducees did not believe in a future judgment

Gen. 3:4

The first doctrine doubted and denied by the Devil is that of the judgment of God!

3. Sadducees believed that the soul perishes along with the body (Annihilation)
4. Sadducees did not believe in angels or demons

Acts 23:8

5. Sadducees did not believe in miracles: They were the equivalent to what we know of today as rationalists –

Matt 22:25-28

2. Verses 29-33 – Divine Revelation:

"You are mistaken Latin (err); literally means "to wander astray", our word planet, wandering stars, Jude 1:13

This is the best description of liberal theology.

1. Not a clear understanding of the Scriptures - (The truth of Scripture) not understanding the Scriptures
2. Not a clear understanding of God's power - (God's nature) or the power of God

This passage teaches 2 great truths about life after death:

Silence – Literally “muzzled”

Application:

1. Let us praise God for - believing minds: Minds that accept Jesus and His Word as the final authority, not mere human speculation.
2. Let us praise God for – the certain hope of the resurrection: That this present life is but a proving ground for the next.
3. Let us praise God for – a genuine faith that produces a life in the here and now worth living.
