"The Cross" Declares God's Great Love! Romans 5:8

Last hours of Jesus life was filled with reaching out to the lost, still loving people to the very end.

The Crowd Surrounding The Cross Reveals The People Jesus Died For.

1. Verses 24-25 – Jesus Died For The Wicked And Religious:

Jesus Died For The Wicked - Pilate -

"And Pilate pronounced sentence" - Matt 27:19

Jesus Died For The Religious Who Are Sometimes Wicked – "their demand should be granted."

Jesus Died For The Wicked – "released the man": Luke 23:18, Barabbas

1 Peter 3:18

2. Verse 26 - Jesus Died For A Bystander:

Luke 23:26

"And when they (Roman Soldiers) led Him away," – The road to Calvary is called "Via Dolorosa"; The Way of Sorrow.

"they laid hold of" can be called pressed into service — "press into public service, compel to go."

3. Verses 27-31 – Jesus Died For The Misdirected:

Jesus declares that the pitiful ones were the women themselves.

Reason: Jesus Is Bearing The Cross Out Of Choice. John 10:18

<u>Reason</u>: Jesus Forbids Their Tears Because Jesus Is Living Victoriously. John 16:33

4. Verses 32-46 - Jesus Died For Criminals And Onlookers:

"the place called The Skull," – Hebrew – "Place of the skull" (Aramaic – Golgotha), Latin – "Calvaria" we get "Calvary"

Jesus Died For Criminals – "there they crucified Him and the criminals,"

Jesus Died For Onlookers – "people stood by, looking on. And even the <u>rulers</u> were sneering at Him,"

Written in Hebrew – or Aramaic was the religious language of the people. The Religious Rejected Jesus Christ:

Written in Greek – This was referred to as the Gentile (pagan) cultural language. <u>The Gentiles Ignored Jesus Christ</u>:

Written in Latin – Was the official language of Roman Empire. <u>The Romans Executed Jesus Christ</u>:
