Each Week, 46,523 divorces take place in the United States.

41% of first marriages end in divorce.60% of second marriages end in divorce.73% of third marriages end in divorce.

Mal. 2:16

This passage is recorded in Matthew 19:1-12; Mark 10:1-12

**The Thought Of Our Passage:** "God's Design For Marriage Is For Life. It Is Sin, Not A Defect In Marriage, That Results In Divorce."

<u>1. Verses 1-5 – Sin Destroys The Marriage</u> <u>2. Verses 6-9 – God's Permanence Of Marriage</u> <u>3. Verses 10-12 – Sin's Consequences On Marriage</u>

## 1. Verses 1-5 – Sin Destroys The Marriage:

Mark 10:1

Mark 9:33 - "And they came to Capernaum;"

Mark 9:14-10:52 – Lessons For Discipleship: Critical Instruction for the training of His disciples.

"region of Judea," – Literally "the borders", which was called "Perea", which means "across".

Mark 10:2

"Pharisees" - means "to separate, or separate ones."

"Testing" - means "to test, to tempt, probing, jabbing, to provoke."

"began to question Him" - Literally "kept on asking Him."

Matthew 19:3

Deut. 24:1

"Indecency" – "nakedness, impurity."

There were 2 Schools of Thought During Jesus' Day:

- 1. Rabbi Hillel (Liberal) The grandfather of Gamaliel. He was Saul's teacher. Rabbinical School View of Divorce was very easy going; the course of least resistance, loose. He was diplomatic, gracious.
- 2. Rabbi Shammai (Conservative) Some grave sin sexual sin, possibly shameful exposure.

Indecency could not be for adultery because God's remedy was execution. Deut. 22:22

Mark 10:3

"What did Moses command you?" – Or What does the Bible say? Have you read your Bible? Jesus takes them right back to the Word.

Mark 10:4

"Moses permitted" - "to allow, give leave."

Duet. 24:1-4

There was a 4-point procedure that would force them to look at the sin!

- 1. Must be a cause, a reason for the divorce.
- 2. Write a certificate of divorce.
- 3. Serve her with the certificate.
- 4. Send her away.

Mark 10:5

"hardness of heart" – Simply said, "Sin"; "It is doing your own thing!" I don't care what God says, this is what I want!

Un-forgiveness – Unwilling to let God cover the offense.

Pride – "I am not at fault"; It's their entire fault.

## 2. Verses 6-9 – God's Permanence Of Marriage:

Mark 10:6

Gen. 1:27 – Jesus goes back to God's original plan of creation.

Marriage Consists Of A Male And Female: "God made them male and female." – God made them, not evolved.

In The Beginning, The Divine Observation: Gen 2:18

God's purpose for marriage is companionship.

Mark 10:7

Genesis 2:24 - "For this cause": What cause? Gen 2:20-23

Marriage Involves Leaving – Severance: "a man shall leave his father and mother," – "leave" – "leave behind, to forsake"

Marriage Is Permanent – "cleave to his wife," (Genesis 2:24) cleave – "to glue, melting of joints together, inseparable bond." (Monogamist)

Mark 10:8

Marriage Is The Highest Of All Relationships – "and the two shall become one flesh;"

Unity – Husband and wife are to be an inseparable team; Body soul and spirit.

Mark 10:9

"joined together' – "Yoked, yoked as oxen are yoked together in unity."

Marriage Is Non-Divisible - "let no man separate."

To separate by divorce is in defiance to God!

Colossians 3:19

#### 3. Verses 10-12 – Sin's Consequences On Marriage:

Mark 10:10

Mark 10:11

Exception Claus For Immorality: Matt. 19:9

immorality – Greek word porneia; get "pornographic" from; "fornication, premarital, extramarital, homosexuality, lesbianism, bestiality, sex outside of the bonds of marriage."

Exception Claus Permanent Abandonment – 1 Cor. 7:15

Non-Biblical Divorce - "Whoever divorces his wife and marries another"

Mark 10:12

Non-Biblical Divorce – "and marries another man, she is committing adultery."

# **Application**:

- In Marriage, We Must Obey God Regardless Of The Hardship Obedience Must Come First, Not Personal Fulfillment: (The World Is Not Our Model).
- 2. As Believers, We Need To Extend Compassion, An Open Door And An Open Heart To Those In The Process And Those Who Have Been Divorced. God Grants Restoration But It Must Include Repentance.
- 3. Those Not Married, Marry Only In The Lord. Only After Prayer For God's Approval And Blessing.
- 4. Those Married Are Not To Expect Too Much From Your Partner. We Need To Remember That The Marriage Union Is Between Two Sinners, And Not Two Angels.
- 5. Strive First And Foremost For One Another's Sanctification. The More Holy Married People Are, The More Blessed They Are.
