On Legal Ground, How Could Jesus Christ Possibly Be A Priest? Writer states – So sufficient Is Jesus As A High Priest That He Fulfilled and Abolished The Earthly Priesthood!

Hebrews 4:14-5:10 – Jesus, Better Than Aaron.

The Thought Of Our Passage: "Jesus' Ability To Sympathize With Sinners And His Call From God Qualify Him To Be Our High Priest."

<u>1. Verses 1-4 – Qualifications For Earthly High Priest</u> 2. Verses 5-10 – Qualifications For Eternal High Priest

1. Verses 1-4 – Qualifications For Earthly High Priest:

Hebrews 5:1

"For" links this chapter to the last paragraph – "Great High Priest", Hebrews 4:14-16

Our Great High Priest Ascended To Heaven, Tempted Yet Sinless, Encourages Us To Claim His Mercy With Confidence.

A High Priest Is Taken From Among Men: "For every high priest taken from among men"

Exodus 28:1

Numbers 3:10

3 Qualifications For The High Priest:

1st Qualification – Appointed To Man With A God-Centered Service: "is appointed on behalf of men in things pertaining to God," – His service centered in that which was spiritual, ritual, and moral.

Revelation 1:6

Ministry Of Offering Sacrifices: "in order to offer both gifts and sacrifices for sins;"

"to offer" - literally means "to bring before".

"both gifts" – the gifts were "Bloodless Offerings" (grain and wine); were voluntary.

"and sacrifices for sins;" – 5 major offerings: <u>Burnt</u>, <u>Meal</u>, <u>Peace</u>, <u>Sin</u>, and <u>Trespass</u>; Leviticus 1-7 – The sin and trespass offerings were mandatory.

Hebrews 5:2

2nd Qualification – A Ministry Of Compassion: "he can deal gently" – (gently, compassion) a compound word to be "moderate in passion"; literally meaning "to suffer a little or moderately."

"with the ignorant" – the source of their sins was ignorance; lack of paying attention to God's commandments. Intentional sins stem from a rebellious heart, fully acquainted with God's law.

"and misguided," – resulting from a deviation from God's Law.

Numbers 15:27-31

"weakness;" - "wrapped around with weakness."

The Great Flaw Of The Priesthood Is The Priest Was A Sinner: He knew about the sins of omission and commission from personal experience. He shared in their human depravity.

Romans 7:19-21

Hebrews 5:3

3rd Qualification – Offering Sacrifices For Sins:

A Priest Needed A Priest: "he is obligated to offer sacrifices for sins, as for the people, <u>so also for himself</u>."

Day of Atonement God said to Aaron he must have a sacrifice for himself first – Leviticus 16:24

Leviticus 16:6

Matthew 5:3-5

Hebrews 5:4

The Call From God: "but receives it when he is called by God,"

"even as Aaron was." – Exodus 28:1; Leviticus 8.

2. Verses 5-10 – Qualifications For Eternal High Priest:

Hebrews 5:5

The Qualifications of Jesus to be the High Priest for all mankind are given. Jesus was <u>Divinely Called</u>, <u>Jesus possessed both Deity/Humanity</u>, Jesus is <u>Compassionate</u>, Jesus is the <u>Sacrifice</u>.

Verses 5-6 – The Appointment/Call Of Christ, Son Of God: "So also Christ did not glorify Himself so as to become a high priest,"

Jesus Did Not Honor Himself: "So also", Hebrews 5:4

Hebrews 10:7

Jesus Received The Divine Appointment: "but He who said to Him, 'YOU ARE MY SON, TODAY I HAVE BEGOTTEN YOU'"; This is a Psalm of David, Psalm 2:7 (Hebrews 1:5)

The Deity And Royal Office Of Jesus: "YOU ARE MY SON," – Hebrews 1:5; Acts 2:36

Humanity Of The Son Of God: Psalm stresses the human nature of the divine Son – "TODAY I HAVE BEGOTTEN YOU"; Hebrews 5:1 – Jesus met the human requirement!

Hebrews 5:6 – Psalm 110:4 (Theme text of Hebrews 7:17, 21).

"Melchizedek" – Hebrews 7; Genesis 14:17-24; Psalm 110:4

"ACCORDING TO THE ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK." – The order of Melchizedek, however, predated the order of Aaron. Jesus Is Both King And Priest.

An Eternal Royal Priest: "YOU ARE A PRIEST FOREVER", Hebrews 7:24-25.

Verses 7-8 – Christ, The Perfect Obedient Son Of God: Hebrews 5:7

Jesus Christ's Humanity: "In the days of His flesh," John 1:14.

God was revealed in the flesh: 1 Timothy 3:16

Hebrews 2:14

Jesus' birth to the age of twelve: Luke 2:40

Jesus, twelve to thirty: Luke 2:52

Jesus Christ Was A Man Of Prayer – "He offered up both prayers and supplications"

Jesus' Great Compassion: "He offered up both prayers and supplications" – Garden of Gethsemane, Matt. 26:36-46; Matthew 26:38.

Gethsemane is the greatest example of humble submission that characterized Jesus' entire life!

"prayers" - "intense entreaty, even to the point of begging."

"supplications" - "the need of protection and help in the midst of calamity."

"loud crying" - refers to "loud, vocal outbursts."

"tears" - the "intense emotional strain", Luke 22:44

"to the One able to save Him from death," - Romans 6:23

Priestly Compassion: by His total awareness of what would happen to Him when the sin of the entire world was placed upon His sinless self.

"Piety" - "reverence, godly fear"; Jesus "feared".

Hebrews 5:8

"He learned obedience from the things which He suffered." – Jesus learned (showed) the total essence of obedience through His sufferings on the cross.

Philippians 2:8

Isaiah 53:4

Verses 9-10 – Jesus Is God's Sacrifice To Redeem Sinful Man: Hebrews 5:9.

"And having been made perfect," – "stresses the completion of a process, fully qualified", John 19:30 – "It is finished."

John 17:4

Jesus Is The Sacrifice For Sin: "obey" – "to listen, and then to obey the word spoken."

"source" - "cause"; only time used in the NT. "Author of eternal salvation,"

Obedience is synonymous with faith.

Hebrews 5:10

"designated" – means "to salute or address"; a compound word which literally means "before the marketplace".

Application:

- 1. For A Person To Be Of Service To Man On Behalf Of God, One Must Be Appointed And God-Centered In His Service.
- 2. A Ministry Of Compassion Results From The Awareness Of Ones Own Weakness And Sinfulness.
- 3. Jesus, The Son, Was Appointed By God His Father, Being Both Deity And Humanity, Thus Making Him The Superior Great High Priest.
- The Compassionate Obedient Son Of God Became The Sacrifice For All Sin, The Source Of Eternal Salvation To Those That Place Their Faith In Him.
