God is the God of Promise. Num. 23:19

Israel needed Joshua 20; God had made a promise in the wilderness to provide "Cites of Refuge," in Ex. 21:13, Num. 35:6-34, Deut. 4:41-43, 19:1-13.

1. Verses 1-7 - Claiming The Promise:

Joshua 21:1

Levi – "joined to"; God did a miraculous work in this family's heart.

Gen. 34:25

Gen 49:5-7

Exodus 32:26

What Levites did in reality was to claim a divine promise.

Numbers 35:1-8

Joshua 21:3

- 1. We should become acquainted with His promises in God's Word.
- 2. We should store them in our hearts and minds.
- 3. We need to personally appropriate and go before the throne of grace.

Verse 2 – "give us"; Verse 3 – "gave": Here is a promise – Isaiah 26:3

"Kohathites" – verses 4-5 – <u>23 cities</u> in the tribes of Judah; Benjamin and Simeon, and Ephraim; This is in the southern kingdom where the temple would be built.

Joshua 21:6

"Gershon" – 13 cities in Eastern Manasseh.

Joshua 21:7

"Merari" – 12 cities in Trans Jordanian which was Reuben and Gad.

2. Verses 8-42 - Trusting In Him:

Verses 8-42 – Is the Assignment of the cities to the Levites.

Numbers 26:62 – says there were 23,000 Levites.

The future depended upon the influence that they would bring in the spiritual realm of Israel.

"Hebron" - "Fellowship, Association."

Joshua 21:14 – "Jattir" – "plenty" (Those that put God first never lack!)

Joshua 21:18 – "Anathoth" – "answers to prayer" (to seek Him, share your heart); "Almon" – "concealed" (We find forgiveness, protection, comfort in Jesus!)

Joshua 21:28 – "Kishion" – "hard" (God makes the hard soft, the impossible possible!); "Daberath" – "word" (God's word never fails!)

Joshua 21:32 – "Kedesh" – "holy place" (Wherever you have been placed is Kedesh, we are set apart for His purposes!)

Joshua 21:39 - "Heshbon" - "stronghold" (Jesus breaks and is our stronghold!) "Jazer" - "helped" (The Lord is our help!)

The furthest city was 10 miles from where the Levites lived and taught the Word.
