1. Verses 1-8 - Discharged:

Francis Schaeffer said, "They thought the holiness of God was being threatened. So these men, who were sick of war, said "The holiness of God demands no compromise." I would to God that the church of the twentieth century learn this lesson. The holiness of God who exists demands that there be no compromise in area of truth."

A 4-point plan for dealing with the problem:

1. <u>Verses 13-14 – They Formed An Investigative Team Of Spiritual</u> Leaders:

"Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest," – This man was a faithful man. He helped bring the plague from God to a stop! Num. 25:6-18 Ps. 106:30-31 Midianite.

2. Verse 15 – Went To The Offenders And Talked Face To Face:

3. <u>Verses 16-18 – They Were Clear In Expressing Their Concerns:</u>

"What is this unfaithful act" – (transgression) is "an act of treachery"

Deut. 12, Lev. 17:8-9

"turning away from following the LORD this day," – This term "turned away" it means that they are not following the Lord any longer; it carries the idea of "Backsliding"; it is gradually moving away from the Lord.

"Rebel" – is the strongest word used 3X (16, 18-19); it carries the idea of, "deliberately resisting God's will and disobeying His Law."

Example: When Israel fell into sin with the Moabites and committed harlotry with the women. (Num. 25)

Joshua 22:18-19

"where the LORD'S tabernacle stands," – No manmade substitute (Altar) for God's presence will ever do.

4. <u>Verse 19 – They Showed Compassion And Generosity In Making The Accusation – "and take possession among us."</u>

Example: Was the rebellion of Achan with the holy things under the ban in Jericho (Joshua 7)

4. Verses 30-34 - Agreement:

Matthew Henry said, "Peace is such a precious jewel that I would give anything for it but truth."

They did fall into idolatry and were taken into Assyrian captivity, 1 Chron. 5:25-26

"Brazen altar": Deut. 12:27 – it was the blood on that altar that was the basis of unity.

It was this bloodless altar that had brought division.

Application:

- 1. As Believers, We Must Be Committed To The Purity Of The Faith, Because Compromise Of Truth Is Costly.
- 2. It Is Dangerous To Judge People's Motives Based Merely Upon Circumstantial Evidence.
- 3. To Help Achieve Reconciliation, We Must Come In Meekness And Honesty. Without Which It Is Impossible To Have Open Discussion Leading To Reconciliation.
- 4. When We Are Falsely Accused We Need To Respond With A Gentle Answer. Prov. 15:1
