Protect – Israel socially from relationship to the people.

Joshua 9:22-23

The very thing that the Gibeonites <u>hoped to retain, they lost</u>; they became slaves through their deception.

Protect – They would be exposed to the things of God.

Joshua 9:24-27

What literally happened here is that Joshua made his bad decision work for him.

The curse became a blessing:

- 1. Joshua 10:10-14 a great miracle was worked.
- 2. Later the tabernacle was pitched in Gibeon. 2 Chron. 1:3
- 3. Later the Gibeonites called Nethinims "given ones"; given to assist the priests. They replaced the Levites in temple service. Ezra 2:43, 8:20
