Judges 18:1-6

Judges 17-18 – Deals With Self-Promotion: It Asks The Question Who Are We Serving?

Judges 17-21 - Are 2 Postscripts.

Judges 17:6

Judges 21:25

Judges 17-18 – We get a glimpse of the family and religious life of the people.

Judges 19–21 – we see the moral, social and political life of the people.

Psalm 75:5-7

We Will Look At 5 Areas In Our Study:

1. Verse 1 – A Stagnated Faith: Judges 18:1

Numbers – they had 64,400

"the tribe of the Danites was seeking an inheritance for themselves to live in," – That is a bit misleading because they had received and inheritance; According to Joshua 19:40-48

Dan's problem was that they didn't go in and possess the land that God gave them.

Judges 1:34

Dan Had 2 Options:

- 1. Dan could repent to God, trust Him and drive the enemy out. (God promised)
- 2. They could look for a comfortable easy place, with no resistance.

The faith of Dan stagnated – they were no longer trusting God for the victory.

2. Verses 2-13 - Dan Spies Out The Land: Judges 18:2

"Go, search the land." – They may find an easier place but there is no better place to be that where God places you!

Judges 18:3-4

The tabernacle was at Shiloh which was conveniently located in the center of Israel.

Judges 18:5

God's will was already known. <u>Dan had been given an inheritance</u> they needed to trust God. <u>Shiloh is where the tabernacle was and to inquire of</u> God.

Judges 18:6

Jeremiah 28

Jeremiah 5:30-31

Paul says that this is one of the marks of the last days - 2 Timothy 4:1-5

This is clear to me – I'm to preach the Word, not what I want, nor what the people want to hear, what God Says.

Judges 18:7

Laish – (Dan) is in the very fertile Hula Valley near the headwaters of the Jordan.

Jordan – literally means "down from Dan".

Judges 18:8-11

People want God in their lives, but only on their terms.

The Requirements: Matt 16:24

The Difficulty: Matthew 7:13-14

The Reality: 2 Timothy 3:12

The Cost: Romans 12:1

Judges 18:12-13

3. Verses 14-21 - The Levite's Promotion: Judges 18:14

They should have destroyed the idols at the minimum.

Judges 18:15-18

You are really in sad shape when your god can be stolen.

Judges 18:19-21

4. Verses 22-26 - Micah Confronts Dan: Judges 18:22-24

"what do I have besides?" - How sad, that his world has been taken! There is nothing else of value! Romans 8 - Nothing Can Separate!

Judges 18:25-26

5. Verses 27-31 – The Founding Of Dan: Judges 18:27-30

Pictures: "sons of Dan set up for themselves the graven image;"

Judges 18:31

Notice that the Scriptures are clear to point out that the house of God was in Shiloh.

1 Kings 12:12-33 – The place is Dan and the gods are golden calves.

The cost Dan paid for their disobedience was high. All Israel's enemies invaded from the North – Dan was the first to be destroyed. 1 Chronicles where the tribes of Israel are listed, Dan is missing – they had disappeared into obscurity. Geographical in name but not as a tribe.

Revelation 7, we are given a list of 144,000 Jews who are sealed servants of the Lord. 12,000 from each tribe, with 1 exception: None from the tribe of Dan are listed.

Application:

- 1. We Should Learn From The Failure Of The Levite To Be Content Where God Has Us And Not Seek Our Own Will Through Self Promotion.
- 2. We Should Learn From The Failure Of Dan We Must Be Careful Not To Stagnate And Look For The Easy Life.
- 3. We Should Learn From The Failure Of The Levite And Dan We Are Called In Scripture To Worship The One And Only True God, In The One True Way Through Faith In His Son Jesus The Christ.
