1. Verses 1-6 – High Cost Of Disobedience:

"Now the angel of the LORD" — "Theophany, or Christophany" which is an appearance of Jesus Christ in the OT.

"Gilgal" – "rolling; rolling away the reproach". This is the place of victory.

"to Bochim" – "Weeping"; When God moved to Bochim, he was saying no victory but weeping. You have turned from Me and the result will be weeping.

(Complacent or Apathy)

"Hate is not the opposite of love, Apathy is." To ignore the God of Calvary is the greatest form of rejection.

The cause of their failure (3 Things):

- 1. Israel Was Satisfied With Status Quo: Joshua 18:3
- 2. Israel Took God's Blessings For Granted; Did Not Acknowledge Him: Deuteronomy 6:10-12
 - 1 Timothy 4:4
 - 1 Thessalonians 5:18

3. Israel Neglected The Word Of God:

3. Verses 11-19 - The Sad Cycle of Sin:

1. Verses 11-13 – Sin: Judges 2:11 "They threw themselves into the sin, the supreme sin, the sin of all sins."

"Baal" – This is the lesser god, the god of the storm, and rains and fertility.

"Ashtaroth" – a female deity goddess of sensual love, fertility and maternity.

How did it happen (3 Things)?

- 1. They lost fellowship with God by incomplete obedience
- 2. They did not consciously remind themselves of the grace of God
- 3. They rejected the Word of God: Galatians 6:8
- 2. Servitude: Verse 14

4. Salvation: Verse - 16

"Judges" – did not wear robes, did not have a courtroom, received no salary; more like Matt Dillon, Wyatt Earp, or our western sheriffs

 - 1. Judges Were Appointed By God: "And when the LORD raised up judges for them,"
 - God Was With The Judges: "the LORD was with the judge,"

3. God Worked Through The Judges: "delivered them from the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge;"

- 1. Sin Is A Serious Matter To The Children Of God.

- 3. There Can Be No Compromise, No Peace Or Coexistence With Sin.
- 4. If We Attempt To Go Partway In Our Commitment To God, We Will Find Ourselves Bound Up In A Spiral That Is Taking Us Quickly Downhill.
