"he oppressed the sons of Israel <u>severely for twenty years</u>." – (Problem was not military but spiritual)

"a prophetess," – A prophet is one who declares the mind and will of God to the people. She is only 1 of very few women to hold that title – Miriam (Ex 15:20), Huldah (2 Kings 22:14-20), Anna at the temple (Luke 2:36) & Phillip's daughters (Acts 21:8-9)

A Command from God! - "the God of Israel, has commanded,"

Barak, Gather 10,000 Soldiers: "take with you ten thousand men"
