1. Verses – 5-9 The Faith That Leads To Jesus:

"Capernaum" means "Village of Consolation, City of Consolation."

Matthew 4:13-17

Luke 7:1-10

Centurion - is equivalent to a modern-day Army Captain.

Centurion's were Gentiles.

Acts 10 Cornelius.

Centurion's were Wealthy.

Luke 7:5 for he loves our nation, and it was he who built us our synagogue."

Let us note 6 things about this mans encounter with Jesus:

1. He Came In Humility: entreating Him, Literally "begging or imploring one who is superior" As a servant seeking from the hand of one's master.

2. He Came Acknowledging Jesus As His Master: and saying, "Lord, Is the equivalent of calling Jesus deity "God." (supreme One); supreme in authority, controller; God, Lord, Master")

3. He Came For The Need Of Another: my servant Luke 7:2

"I will come and heal him." Either this is "Presumption" or "Divine Promise!"

4. He Came Knowing His Own Unworthiness:

We must see ourselves as sinners:

He marveled, The word marveled – "To wonder, a wonderful thing, a marvel, marvelous" Jesus was "Amazed or Marveled."

The Bible speaks of the torment of darkness in hell (Matthew 8:12; 22:13; 25:30; 2 Peter 2:17).

The Bible speaks of the torment of no rest (Revelation 14:11).

The Bible tells of a torment that produces weeping and gnashing of teeth (Matthew 8:12).

A place of separation: Those who are in hell are eternally separated from the presence of God (2 Thessalonians 1:9).

A place "where [the] worm does not die, and the fire is not quenched." Mark 9:44
