1. Verses 1-7 - Failure:

Lev 10:1

Lev 9:23-24

Nadab - "Liberal"; Abihu - "Worshipper of Him"

They were the wrong people to be handling the incense and presenting it to the Lord. Ex. 30:7-10

The incense – was to symbolize prayer to God. Psalm 141:1-2

took <u>their</u> respective firepans; They also used the wrong instruments, Ex 40:9

They Acted at the Wrong Time: for it was only on the annual Day of Atonement, Lev. 16

They Acted Under the Wrong Authority:

Lev 16:12

offered strange fire (Unauthorized or Foreign); The worship all started from the Brazen Alter where the fire of worship was ignited.

Ex 30:9

King Uzziah Deliberately Sinned Against the Lord. 2 Ch 26:19

Bottom Line – regardless of the nature of the sin, their actions were presumptuous; self-willed!

Early in the Church Age, the death of Ananias and Sapphira served as a warning to the saints not to try to lie to God: (Acts 5)

Application:
