Leviticus 25-26 describes Israel’s future in their land. In fact, the word “land” is used 39X in these two chapters.

shall be holy – The animal was holy – which meant it was set apart (“sanctified”) and belonged to the Lord.

Firstborn were set apart for the Lord at the first Passover Ex.

Verses 28-29 – No Loopholes: Things Devoted To The Lord Lev 27:28

The phrase “devoted to destruction” – this meant more than just a vow; The Hebrew word carried the idea of being cut off or shut up – That which has been cut off from common use and devoted to God.
