Leviticus - Teaches Separation and Communion.

Leviticus 1-7 The Offerings To The Lord: There were 5 offerings and each one was a picture of Jesus Christ.

Leviticus 1 Burnt Offering: burnt offering "That which ascends, that which goes up"; It is called "The Whole burnt offering"; Jesus gave all for us; The worshipper is to be taught that entire consecration is essential to true worship.

Leviticus 2 Grain Offering: Represents Jesus Christ as the Bread of Life: The Grain Offering was Voluntary – The Grain Offering was a Product of the Soil - The grain represents the fruit of our labor; All that we do is to be dedicated unto God.

Leviticus 3 Fellowship Offering: Pictures Jesus Christ as our peace; the reality that the forgiveness of sins brings peace and communion with God and with God's people, and joyful thanksgiving of worship to God.

sins unintentionally – "mistake, error"; The repeated phrase "through ignorance" (4:2, 13, 22, 27; 5:15)

Sin Offering –The sacrifice of animals can't take away sin or change the human heart; Jesus was our sin offering, who was slaughtered outside the camp (city), denied the presence of His Father because He became sin for us. Jesus was the perfect Sacrifice, bringing forgiveness of sin.
