Leviticus 8:14-29 Sacrifices Offered:

The “ram of consecration [ordination]”; took the place of the fellowship offering, symbolizing their communion with one another and with the Lord. The word translated “consecration” or “ordination” means “to fill up.”

Leviticus 8:30 The Priests Anointed:

This meant that both they and their garments were “sanctified,” set apart by God for His exclusive use.
