neglect – Attitude Towards Revelation

drift away - Result Of Neglect

salvation - That Which Is Neglected

The Thought Of Our Passage: "Man Was Created, Man Has Become Depraved. But Through Jesus' Death, He Has Tasted Death For Everyone."

- 1. Verses 5-6 God's Intention For Man

1. Verses 5-6 - God's Intention For Man:

Hebrews 2:5

Hebrews 1:4-2:18 – Jesus Better Than Angels.

Hebrews 1:4-2:4 – Jesus Superior In Ministry As The Son Of God; Hebrews 2:5-18 – Jesus Superior In Ministry As The Son Of Man.

Hebrews 2:5-9 – Jesus' Superiority To Angels Is No Contradiction In His Humanity.

Man's Supreme Favor: "For He did not subject to angels the world to come, concerning which we are speaking."

Hebrews 1:14

"world" – refers to the inhabited earth of mankind. It literally means "to remain in the house." The earth is the house in which man abides today.

"world to come," – Literally, it is "the one which is about to be." It refers to the millennial kingdom, promised in the Davidic covenant, 2 Sam. 7:16.

Revelation 20:6

The angelic structure that is under God is going to change when Jesus returns.

2. Verses 7-8 - Man's Intention Delayed:

Hebrews 2:7

Psalm 8:5-6

4 Assertions Are Made About Man:

1. Man's Temporary Demotion: "THOU HAST MADE HIM FOR <u>A</u> LITTLE WHILE LOWER THAN THE ANGELS;"

"THOU HAST MADE HIM" - "Man has been created by God."

"FOR <u>A LITTLE WHILE LOWER THAN THE ANGELS</u>;" – There is a definite order within the universe: God—angels—man—animals—plants—inanimate objects.

Men are limited to life on earth in their present bodies.

2. Man's Unique Dignity: "CROWNED HIM WITH GLORY AND HONOR," – Made in the image and likeness of God. Genesis 1:26

1 Corinthians 11:7

God's Image, God's Likeness, Unique To Man Only.

Genesis 9:6

3. Man Assigned Over God's Works: "APPOINTED HIM OVER THE WORKS OF THY HANDS;" – Authority and power.

Man was created on the sixth day, Genesis 1:26

Man's destiny was to rule.

Hebrews 2:8

4. Man's Unrivalled Dominion: "THOU HAST PUT ALL THINGS IN SUBJECTION UNDER HIS FEET." Genesis 1:26-30

God Excluded Nothing From The Domain Of Man – "For in subjecting all things to him, <u>He left nothing that is not subject to him."</u>

Adam, the representative man, lost that original dominion through his sin in the Garden of Eden. Genesis 3:17-19

3. Verse 9 - God's Intention Fulfilled:

Hebrews 2:9

Jesus, The Second Adam, is God who came in flesh, to undo all that the First Adam recklessly threw away.

4 Things That Jesus Did:

1. He Became Man: "made for a little while lower than the angels,"

John 1:14

"namely, Jesus," – The name Jesus: This is referring to the virgin birth. Matthew 1:21

2. He Died For Man: "because of the suffering of death."

- **3. His Achievement Was Through His Humanity:** "crowned with glory and honor,"
- **4. Jesus Experienced Death In Full Strength:** "that by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone."

Romans 5:17

Ephesians 2:6-7

Christ totally experienced death. Taste – common metaphor, "to experience"; not a sip or sample but full experience of eating.

Jesus died "for every man." 1 Timothy 2:6

1 John 2:2

Application:

- 1. Man Has Been Elevated Above All Of God's Creation. Only Man Has Been Created In The Image And Likeness Of God.
- 2. The First Adam Brought Sin, Resulting In Man's Separation From God, His Fellow Man And Creation.
- 3. The Second Adam, Jesus Christ, Came To Redeem And Reverse The Curse Placed Upon Man And The World Through His Death.
- 4. Man Cannot Change Himself. Only Through A New Spiritual Birth Can Man Experience Peace And God's Fulfillment.
