1. Verses 1-11 - Ministry In Malta:

Acts 28:1

276 people on board, Acts 27:37

Acts 27:23-24

Acts 27:41-44

(Map) Malta or Melita, which means "refuge"; This was an island that was sparsely populated. 17 miles long by 9 miles in width; About 60 miles from the nearest point of Sicily.

Acts 28:2

"And the natives" – Phoenicians in origin, to the Greeks anybody who did not speak Greek was a "barbarian"

Acts 28:3

Satan uses all sorts of different things, storms and snakes. (2 Cor. 11:3; 1 Peter 5:8).

Note: The Viper Attacked Paul While He Was Serving Others!

Why Paul Did Not Panic: God had spoken and promised Paul that he was to testify, Acts 23:11; 27:24; Paul had the assurance of God's Word.

A Principle For Life & Ministry: When You Are Serving and Doing God's Will, And A Viper (Adversity, Attacks) Bites You, Shake It Off!

"leading man of the island" – or "Chief Official" is the exact technical term for the person representing Rome in that place.

"Publius" – name means "popular"

Acts 28:8

"afflicted with recurrent fever and dysentery" – It is known today as "Malta Fever." Discovered in 1887; The micro-organism which was traced to goats milk from the Maltese goats, lasted about 4 months, but can persist for 2-3 years.

Paul Took The Opportunity To Go And Pray:

"And at the end of three months" - November-February, March.

"Twin Brothers for its figurehead." - "Twin Sons Of Zeus", Castor and Pollux.

- 2. Peace Versus Turmoil The Storm, Shipwreck, Serpent; Paul Had Peace No Matter What, Because His Mind Stayed On Christ.
- 3. Determination God Said to Testify In Rome, Then Rome Here I Come.
- 4. Trust In God, Rest In God, Move Forward By Faith To Do The Work God Has Called Us To Do: We Should Move Forward, Knowing God Is With Us and That He Is Leading Us Each Step Of The Way.
