Numbers – Israel is tested in trusting God and found guilty of the sin of Unbelief.

1. Verses 1-3 – Backbiting:

Numbers 10:33

Num 11:35 – "and they remained at Hazeroth." This is 40 miles Northeast of Sinai.

Micah 6:4

Miriam – God had used Miriam to save her younger brother's life Ex. 2:1-10, and she was also a prophetess who led the Jewish women in praising God after the deliverance of Egypt Ex 15:20-21

Aaron – Aaron was the elder brother in the family Ex. 7:7, appointed by God not only to assist Moses in confronting Pharaoh Ex. 4:10-17, but also to serve as the first high priest.

spoke against – the verb "spoke" is feminine in form, and Miriam alone was disciplined by the Lord.

Degrading Moses by Suggesting that He Had Committed a Questionable Act: "because of the Cushite woman whom he had married (for he had married a Cushite woman);"

Numbers 12:2

Miriam finally got around to her real complaint: "Has the Lord indeed spoken only through Moses? Has He not spoken through us as well?"

The real issue was Jealousy: "Hasn't God spoken to us also, not just Moses?" – Yes!

Numbers 12 – Jealousy or Envy – "a feeling of discontent or covetousness with regards to another's advantages, successes, position or possessions" Envy is the chief enemy of unity because it breeds discord and discontentment.
