Balak, king of Moab, didn't realize that God had told Israel not to attack Moab Deut. 2:9

Numbers 22:5

Balaam - name means "devourer of the people"

Pethor, which is near the River, distance of 300 miles

Balaam and the Church Today:

- The Way of Balaam: 2 Peter 2:15-16 Balaam knew the right way, but deliberately chose the wrong way because he wanted to make money and loved money. He kept "playing with the will of God" by trying to get "a different viewpoint"
- The Error of Balaam: Jude 11 "The error of Balaam" is thinking that one can get away with this kind of rebellion. Balaam prostituted his gifts and sought to destroy God's people. God turned Balaam's curses into blessings (Deut. 23:4-5).

 The Doctrine of Balaam: Rev. 2:14 – "You can violate your separated position and get away with it!" "You are God's chosen people, certainly a little friendship with your neighbors will not hurt you! "Turning the grace of ... God into lasciviousness"
