First 3 Petitions have to do with God's Glory (God's Side)

1. Petition Hallowed be Thy name. (Foundational Petition)
2. Petition 'Thy kingdom come. (The Program of Prayer)
3. Petition Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. (Deals with God's Plan)

Last 3 Petitions deal with man's need (Man Side)

4. Petition "Give us our daily bread" (Physical Life) Present
5. Petition "Forgive our debts" (Mental Life) Past
6. Petition "Lead us not ... deliver us " (Spiritual Life) Future

3. The Supplication
4. The Surety

1. The Substance

Bread – is speaking in a broad term meaning "all of man's physical needs." He is referring to everything we need for our earthly existence. We are speaking of Cloths, shelter, transportation, and medical needs.
