1. Verse - 13 Salt Of The Earth:

• Matt 5:13

You are the salt of the earth: "You" is in the emphatic, lit. "You and you alone are the salt of the earth."

• Ex 19:3-6

You are follows the Beatitudes

• 2 Tim. 3:14

Salt – In Roman times was valued that Roman Soldiers were given rations of salt and would revolt if it was changed. English word **salary** - "Salt Money" we use the phrase "The man is not worth his salt"

5 Thoughts About Salt

1. Salt is Preservative:

Gen 3 a perfect world began to rot because of sin.

Gen 19 God could not bring His judgment upon Sodom because of Lot's presence in the city.

- 4. Salt Makes us Thirsty:

- 5. Salt is a Common Substance:
 - 1 Cor. 1:26-31

Did you notice that Jesus doesn't say you should be salt, or become like salt. Rather, he says you are salt.

- 1. Salt Was Made For a Purpose: Jesus said "But IF the salt become tasteless, how will it be made salty again?"
 - Matt 5:15
- 2. Salt Was Not Refined:
 - Luke 14:34-35

2. Verses - 14-16 Light Of The World:

You are the light of the world - "You" (emphatic) "You alone are the light of the world"
