# Series "Jesus Is First" "Seeking The Things Above" Colossians 3:1-4 Part-10

It does little good if Christians <u>declare</u> and <u>defend</u> the truth, but <u>fail to demonstrate it in their lives</u>. Character determines the nature of our conduct!

Galatians 1:4-5; Titus 1:16

We need to start with is **Doctrine**; that is what Paul always did; then he goes to **Duty. Principle – Practice**, **Wealth – Walk** 

"A good teacher not only informs people of what is wrong, but also what is right."

**Thought Of Our Passage:** "Genuine Spiritual Living Is Built On The Believer's Association With The Risen Christ."

- 1. Verse 1 Believers Raised With Christ
- 2. Verses 2-3 Believers Died With Christ
- 3. Verse 4 Believers Will Be Revealed With Christ

#### 1. Verse 1 - Believers Raised With Christ:

Colossians 3:1

"Therefore" – what is the "therefore" there for? Paul has warned about the dangerous teachings that had crept into the church: Verses 16-17 – Legalism; Verses 18-19 – Mysticism; Verses 20-23 – Asceticism.

Colossians 2:20-23

- 1. Colossians 1 DOCTRINE: CHRIST'S PREEMINENCE DECLARED.
- 2. Colossians 2 DANGER: CHRIST'S PREEMINENCE DEFENDED.
- 3. Colossians 3-4 DUTY: CHRIST'S PREEMINENCE DEMONSTRATED.

Romans 1-11 – Paul lays out systematically our great salvation, Romans 12-16 – practical; Romans 12:1.

Galatians 1-4 Doctrinal, then 5-6 Practical; Galatians 5:1.

Philippians 1 lays out the doctrinal teaching, then in Philippians 2-4 – Living.

Philippians 2:1

1 Thessalonians 1-3 Doctrine, then 4-5 Duty; 1 Thessalonians 4:1.

Colossians 2:20

"if" – "since you have;" it is not a question but it was a true statement.

Colossians 2:23

The Scope Of Our Position: (Co-Resurrected) "you have been raised up with Christ" – This is the basis of our holiness, Romans 6:1-10.

Our Spiritual Position Is Identified With His Spiritual Location: Our new potential for every Christian!

Colossians 2:12-13

2 Corinthians 5:17

Paul mentions 4X in 4 Verses "Christ." That's Our Focus!

The Command For The New Pattern Of Life: "keep seeking the things above," – The Goal Is Heaven, So Seek The Things Above!

"keep seeking" – it is "to be continual, to pursue with diligence."

What are we to seek? "things above,"

That is Jesus Christ Himself. Matthew 7:7-8

We Are Seated With Christ: "where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God." – "position of majesty and authority," Psalm 110:1.

Jesus is now seated because He completed His Work of redemption.

Hebrews 1:3; Hebrews 10:11-14

#### 2. Verses 2-3 - Believers Died With Christ:

Colossians 3:2

"Set your mind on the things above," - (<u>Positive</u>) same as Colossians 3:1.

"Set your mind on the things above," – "the thoughts and attention need to be continually directed towards this goal of the things above."

"You must not only <u>seek heaven</u>, you must <u>think heaven!</u>" We need to be heavenly minded so we can be earthly good.

"Set" – "to set continually," daily desire and urgency.

(<u>Negative</u>) "not on the things that are on earth." – This does not mean that the Christian is to live in a mystical fog and neglect the affairs of this world!

Material Things - Our life is our money.

Immaterial Things – Earthly honor, position, advancement.

Matthew 6:21

## Our perspective on this temporal life should be filtered through the eternal. It's <u>not going to last</u>, it's <u>all going to burn</u>, it's <u>not going to matter!</u>

#### The mind-set begins with prayer: John 15:7

Colossians 3:3

A Past Reality – (Justification) "For you have died" – We have died to sin, Romans 6:2; Colossians 2:20; Galatians 2:20.

A Present Truth – (Security & Safety) "and your life is hidden with Christ in God." – The term "hidden" – "safety or secrecy," John 10:28-29.

### Life has so many changing factors; we are secure in Jesus Christ; Satan or man cannot touch us!

"hidden" – "concealed, unseen;" the believer's life is not understood by the watching world.

#### 3. Verse 4 - Believers Will Be Revealed With Christ:

Colossians 3:4

"When Christ, who is our life," – Not only have we died, but Jesus Christ is our life.

A Future Expectation – (Future Position) "is revealed," – "appears, open display;" This is the glorious Second Coming, Matthew 24:29-31.

Revelation 19:11-16

## Our final destination is not the grave, cemetery, a crypt, or mausoleum, urn or niche, but with Him in glory!

Romans 8:29-31; Philippians 3:20-21

#### **Application:**

- 1. Our Evaluation Of This Temporal Life Should Be Filtered Through The Eternal. It's Not Going To Last, It's All Going To Burn, It's Not Going To Matter.
- 2. We Should Pray That Our Minds Would Be Set On Things Above. The Goal Is Heaven, So We Should Be Seeking The Things Above.
- 3. We Rejoice In Anticipation Of Our Future In Him. Our Final Destination Is Not The Grave, Cemetery, Crypt, Mausoleum, Urn or Niche, But With Jesus Christ In Glory.
