Malachi - means "My messenger"

Note the described conditions during Malachi's Ministry:

- 1. Poor crops and a faltering economy (Mal. 3:11)
- 2. God's people involved with intermarriage with heathens (Mal. 2:11)
- 3. Defilement of the priesthood (Mal. 1:6)
- 4. Oppression of the poor (Mal. 3:5)
- 5. Lack of support for the temple (Mal. 3:8-10)
- 6. A general disdain of religion (Mal. 2:13)

Why are marriages, families, and churches in such financial hardships?

- 1. People do not know what the Bible has to say about money.
- 2. Some have been taught Biblical giving but have forgotten what the Bible says.
- 3. Some may know what the Bible says but allow fear to control them, and are not trusting God that He will take care of them if they obey what He says.

1. Verses 7-8 - Robbing God:

My statutes, "commandment, decree, law, measure, ordinance, task"

James 4:8-10

Mal 3:8

Foundational Truths About Resources:

1. We are commanded to give in order to break the sinful, selfcentered nature of our hearts: Eph 4:28

- 2. We are blessed more through our giving than our receiving: Mal. 3:7-12
- 3. All I have has come to me from God: (James 1:17)
- 4. All I have belongs to God; I am a steward of God: (1 Cor 4:1)
- 5. I need to be content with what God has entrusted to me. (Phil 4:11)

In Tithes – "The word "tithe" comes from a Hebrew word that means "ten" A tithe is 10 percent of one's grain, fruit, animals, or money."

Malachi 3:10 "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse,

Abraham - gave tithes to Melchizedek, acknowledging that Melchizedek was the representative of the Most High God (Gen. 14:20; Heb. 7).

Jacob - vowed to God that he would tithe (Gen. 28:22)

and offerings – This is giving above our tithes.

2. Verses 9-11 – Robbing Yourselves:

Whenever we rob God, we always rob ourselves. "You are cursed with a curse, for you are robbing Me."
