**The Thought Of Our Passage:** "Jesus, God's Son, Who Through The One Sacrifice Of Himself, Brought About Complete Forgiveness Of Sin, And Cleansed Conscience."

- 1. Verses 1-4 The Need Of A Better Sacrifice:

Hebrews 10:1

"For the Law," - Hebrews 9:28

#### 4 Reasons Why We Needed A Better Sacrifice:

1. Verse 1 – Imperfect, Lacking Substance: "For the Law, since it has only a shadow of the good things to come" – The law had a "shadow"; means "outline and image, the true representation as a picture."

Colossians 2:17

"and not the very form of things," – Christ is the "very image."

- 2. Verse 1 Imperfect Cleansing: "can never, by the same sacrifices which they offer continually year by year, make perfect."
- 3. Verse 2 Imperfect Conscience: Hebrews 10:2.

**4. Verses 3-4 – Imperfect Reminder:** Hebrews 10:3.

Leviticus 16:21-22

Romans 11:27

"take away" - literally means "to lift up away from."

#### 2. Verses 5-18 – Jesus Christ The Sufficient Sacrifice:

Hebrews 10:5

"Therefore," – The author has made clear that the never-ending sacrifices revealed that persons were never cleansed; their conscience cried out!

#### 6 Reasons Why The Sacrifice Of Jesus Is Sufficient:

1. Verses 5-9 – Sacrifice Of Jesus Was God's Will: (God's Will Was Jesus The Sacrifice) Hebrews 10:5 – "when He comes into the world," John 1:9.

"He says," – or "God says"; The author quotes Psalm 40:6-8, A Psalm of David, Messianic Psalm.

Although God commanded the offering of blood sacrifices within the Mosaic covenant, He never accepted them as the basis of divine justification.

Psalm 40:6 – "My ears You have opened;" – "bored or to dig"; Ear open to hear God to obey!

Hebrews 10:6

"YOU HAVE TAKEN NO PLEASURE." - Hebrews 10:8.

"SCROLL OF THE BOOK" – "scroll" literally means "head".

Luke 24:27

Hebrews 10:8-9

(God Wanted Obedience)

God wants us to be a living sacrifice – Romans 12:1.

#### 2. Verse 9 – Jesus Himself Established The New Covenant:

"He takes away the first in order to establish the second."

Jesus Abolished The Old Covenant: "He takes away" – "to take away (violently), abolish, murder, put to death, kill, slay, take away, take up"; "the first."

Jesus Established The New Covenant: "in order to establish the second."

#### 3. Verse 10 - Jesus Sanctified Believers: Hebrews 10:10.

"will we have been sanctified" — "to set apart, to set apart for special purpose, consecration."

## <u>Sanctification Applies To 4 Different Stages Of The Believer's Salvation</u>:

- a. The Ministry Of The Holy Spirit Before Conversion: Galatians 1:15; 2 Thess. 2:13.
- b. The Time Of Regeneration: 1 Corinthians 1:2; 6:11.
- c. The Present Cleansing Of The Christian By The Spirit Through The Scriptures: John 17:17.
- d. The Total Separation From The Effects Of Sin When The Believer Receives The Incorruptible, Immortal Body: Ephesians 5:26-27.

## **4. Verses 11-13 – Jesus Completes The Sacrificial Work:** Hebrews 10:11.

"Every priest" – the new covenant needs only one Jesus Christ.

"stands" – the priests always stood in their service, (Reminder that sin was ever present).

"daily" - The work of the priests went on "daily".

"take away" – literally means "to lift up from around"; The metaphor of stripping off a soiled garment, closely wrapped around a body.

Hebrews 10:12-13

"waiting from that time onward" - 2 Peter 3:9.

5. Verse 14 – Jesus Perfected The Believers: Hebrews 10:14.

"For by one offering He has perfected" — "to complete, accomplish, or finish, fulfill, full age mature."

"He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified." – Eternal Security For Those In Christ.

"those who are sanctified." – Literally "them that are being sanctified."

6. Verses 15-18 – Jesus Forgave Sins: Hebrews 10:15 – (The Witness Of The Holy Spirit).

Hebrews 10:16-17 – He quotes Jeremiah 31:31-34, part of a passage he'd also quoted in Hebrews 8:7-12.

"Holy Spirit also testifies to us;" - Jeremiah 31:31

Romans 5:5

Hebrews 10:16-17

In what sense does God no longer "remember" sins? In His omniscience, He is aware of them, but <u>He will not hold those sins against the person</u>.

Hebrews 10:18

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### Application:

- 1. Man's Deepest And Greatest Need Is Forgiveness Of Sins. We Are Not Sinners Because We Sin. We Sin Because We Are Sinners.
- 2. Old Covenant Constantly Reminded The Worshipper Of Their Sins. Now In Christ, The Believer Constantly Remembers The Death Of His Savior Without A Guilty Conscience For Sins.
- 3. There Is Eternal Security For Those Who Are Truly In Christ: Hebrews 10:14 "For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified."
- 4. The Logic Of Hebrews 10 Is God Has Totally Removed And Forgiven The Sins Of A Believer. The Christian Does Not Have To Offer Animal Sacrifices Or Work Because He Is Forgiven Of Sins And Accepted In Christ.
