John Reveals 3 Facts about Our Confidence in Prayer:

1. The Source of Our Confidence: And this is the confidence which we have before Him,

confidence – "frankness of speech" or "unreservedness" boldness"; It speaks of one who has nothing to hide.

John has used this word 3X in his letter: 1 John 5:14

Confidence at the Second Coming: 1 John 2:28

Confidence in Judgment: 1 John 4:17

confidence – "childlike confidence that a believer approaches God"

2. The Substance of The Confidence: that, if we ask anything according to His will,

"God has not promised to answer merely because we asked. The Promise is Based Upon The Asking According to His will."
