- 1. We need to know that we are sinners, that we are separated from God because He is holy and we are unholy. Rom. 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
- 2. Our sins have earned us death. Rom. 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- 3. Jesus out of His great love for us has paid for our sins. Rom. 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.
- 4. Turn our lives over to Him, Jesus becomes savior when we accept him as Lord. Rom. 10:9 that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved;
- 10 for with the heart man believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.
