This passage is recorded in Matthew 24-25; Mark 13; Luke 21

Outline Of The Chapter: Mark 13:1-13 – The Final Days Mark 13:14-23 – The Great Tribulation Mark 13:24-27 – The Second Coming Of Jesus Mark 13:28-37 – The Last Generation

"The Tribulation" is a period of 7 years. The "Great Tribulation" is the last 3 1/2 years of the Tribulation period. (Dan. 9:24-27)

"Pre-Tribulationist"; That prior to the tribulation, the Church will be raptured from the earth; That the Church will not go through the tribulation. 1 Thess 5:9

Rev 3:10

1 Thess. 4:17 – "caught" – the Latin word "Rapture"; but the Greek is the word "Harpazo" which means "to seize, to catch up, snatch away."

The Thought Of Our Passage: "God's Revelation Of The Future Is Not To Puff Us Up, But Provoke Us To Live And Develop Christlikeness."

<u>1. Verses 1-2 – Destruction Of The Temple</u> <u>2. Verses 3-13 – World In Relentless Trouble</u>

1. Verses 1-2 – Destruction Of The Temple:

Mark 13:1

Tuesday, called "The Day Of Controversy." Mark 12:38-40

Matt. 23:37-39

"wonderful buildings!" – Herod The Great started rebuilding the temple in 20 B.C.; it had been 46 years in the building. It was completed in 64 AD; 85 years to build it; 70 AD destroyed.

Mark 13:2 – This was fulfilled in 70 AD when the Roman General Titus placed a siege on Jerusalem.

We need to look at this passage as the "Telescopic Principle"; that there was a partial fulfillment (40 years later), but there will be a final fulfillment (final days).

2. Verses 3-13 – World In Relentless Trouble:

Mark 13:3

(Pictures): "And as He was sitting on the Mount of Olives opposite the temple,"

Ezekiel 11:22-25; Zech 14

Disciples Asked 2 Questions:

- 1. "when will these things be," (Destruction of the Temple?)
- 2. "<u>what</u> will be the sign when all these things are going to be fulfilled?"
 (Destruction of the temple?)

Matthew 24:3

Between The First And Second Coming Of Jesus, History Will Be Marked By 5 Relentless Troubles:

1. Verse 5 – Deception – Mark 13:5

"misleads" – Deceives – Greek "Planao"; our word "Planet", "to stray, to wander, out of orbit."

Mark 13:9 – "But <u>be on your guard;</u>" Mark 13:23 – "But <u>take heed;</u>" Mark 13:33 – "<u>Take heed, keep on the alert;</u>" Mark 13:35 – "Therefore, <u>be on the alert</u>" Mark 13:37 – "And what I say to you I say to all, <u>Be on the</u> alert!" "take heed" – "stay awake" Don't sleep, but stay awake and keep watch!

2. Verse 6 – Beware Of False Messiahs – Mark 13:6

Islam/Muslims – False Prophet Muhammad – Jesus is just a prophet not God! Our Jesus is their Antichrist. Our Antichrist is their redeemer.

Jehovah's Witnesses; J.W.'s Watchtower Society

3. Verses 7-8 – "Wars" – International Unrest – Mark 13:7-8

Revelation 6, 9, 16,

 Verse 8 – Natural Disasters – "there will be earthquakes in various places;"

Rev 16:18, 20

3 million earthquakes a year.

"there will also be famines" – A famine in Rome, 400 and 800 AD, over 90%, of the population of the city of Rome fell because of famine and plague.

Luke 21:11 – Plagues – "virus", Diseases

Unnatural Disasters – Luke 21:11

"These things are merely the beginning of birth pangs." – Two thousand years of these milder contractions, Labor pains – Isa. 13:8
