Acts 6:8

Martyr – is a person who dies for his or her beliefs; Christian Martyr – is a person who is killed because of his or her witness to Jesus Christ. Acts 1:8 "You shall be my witnesses" – The Greek word is mar'-toos where we get our word martyr from.

"The God of glory" Note where Stephen starts is with God! "The starting point of salvation is not man's search for God, but God's search for man."

"Mesopotamia," the heart of the middle East, Babylon.

"before he lived in Haran," modern day Iraq

Abraham saw Canaan as a land he was passing through:

Acts 7:37

The Hope of Israel was <u>not the Law</u> but the <u>deliverer Jesus Christ</u>. Deut 18:15

Verses 40-43 – Israel Worshiped Idols: Amos 5:25-27 and Isa. 66:1-2

Israel thought that because they had their tabernacle, they were safe from harm, and God had to bless them.

4. Acts 7:46-50 The Temple:

Israel erred in that they tried to confine God.

5. Acts 7:51-60 The Response:

Observation and Interpretation leads to Application:

"Son of Man" – Ezekiel passages signaled that God's Messiah would save all men not just Jews.

Acts 7:57-60

Application:

- 1. History reveals that God's presence and glory cannot be confined to any one place no matter how sacred. It's not about structures or systems.
- 2. We, like Israel, suffer from spiritual blindness and are constantly tempted and sin through resisting God and His chosen instruments.
- 3. The Law and the Temple and every sacred institution are capable of abuse; The Spirit and truth being infinitely more important than external rites and ordinances.
- 4. Jesus Christ the Messiah is the goal of the law and the prophets, and that, in accepting Him, the true Jew fulfills the purpose of the God of His fathers and the sacred destiny of His race.
- 5. God wants nothing less than a personal relationship with Himself.
