Series "Jesus Unveiled" "The Four Trumpets" Revelation 8:7-13 Part-18

"A curse on nature is a curse on mankind and on the earth."

In Revelation 8:7-13 We See God's Judgment on Man Coming Through Nature.

Key Verse Of Revelation: Revelation 1:19 – the book has 3 parts:

- 1. "Things which you have seen" Rev. 1 Vision of the coming of Jesus.
- 2. "The things which are" Rev. 2-3 7 Churches.
- 3. "The Things which shall take place after these things" Rev. 4-22.

Revelation 4-5 – Heavenly Scenes

Rev 6-19 – The Tribulation – Consists Of 3 Sets Of Judgments.

Thought Of Our Passage: First Four Trumpets Wreak Havoc On Nature, But A Curse On Nature Is A Curse On Mankind.

<u>1. Verse 7 – 1st Trumpet – Destruction of Vegetation</u>

2. Verses 8-9 – 2nd Trumpet – Destruction of Seas

3. Verses 10-11 – 3rd Trumpet – Destruction of Rivers

4. Verses 12-13 – 4th Trumpet – Destruction of Luminaries

1. Verse 7 – 1st Trumpet – Destruction of Vegetation:

Revelation 8:7

"The first sounded," – Silence has now been broken, Revelation 8:1.

The Seventh Seal Transitions From Grace To Judgment, Because The Seventh Seal Is The Trumpet And Bowl Judgments. Revelation 8:6

"And the first sounded," – The sound of the trumpet is to give warning!

Trumpets 1-4 are on <u>Natural Objects</u> – earth, trees, grass, sea, rivers, and lights of heaven. Trumpets 5-6 are inflicted on Men, not natural objects.

"and there came hail" – Exodus 9:18-26 – 7th Plague of Egypt.

Joshua 10:11

Revelation 16:21

"and fire" - a form of lightning? Is this like Sodom and Gomorrah revisited?

Genesis 19:24-25

"mixed with blood" – (blood, 90% water) It could mean that both man and animals die (bloodshed) as a result of the hail and fire, Exodus 9:19.

Exodus 9:25

"third" – 12X in the Trumpet Judgments; it is literal.

The 10 Plauges of Egypt were directed at Pharaoh and the people of Egypt but also the gods of Egypt. Egyptians worshiped nature, so today, persons worship the <u>Creation</u> but not the <u>Creator</u>!

"third of the trees were burned up," trees - literally "fruit trees".

"all the green grass was burned up." – Man is dependent upon nature.

Lesson: We should not take for granted the trees and plants God has given to us.

2. Verses 8-9 – 2nd Trumpet – Destruction of Seas:

Revelation 8:8

"something like a like a great mountain" – not that it is a great mountain, but <u>something like</u> a great mountain (fireball).

Psalm 46:1-2

"a third of the sea became blood" – polluted, from the dead animals? Exodus 7:19-21, in Egypt – Nile.

Revelation 8:9

Ecological Disaster: "and a third of the creatures, which were in the sea and had life, died;"

Economic Disaster: "and a third of the ships were destroyed."

Lesson: We take for granted the blessings of the oceans and seas; Ships that supply materials.

<u>3. Verses 10-11 – 3rd Trumpet – Destruction of Rivers</u>:

Revelation 8:10

"and a great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch" – meteor, Revelation 6:13.

"springs" - "wells, fountains"; the very source of water.

Revelation 8:11 – "star is called Wormwood" – sorrow – bitter – calamity, Exodus 15:23-25.

"and a third of the waters became wormwood;" - God directed the stars.

Joshua 10:11

"and many men died from the waters, because they were made bitter." – Lethal water that will kill people.

Lesson: We take for granted the blessings of fresh water, rivers and springs. (Water will be precious)

<u>4. Verses 12-13 – 4th Trumpet – Destruction of Luminaries:</u>

Revelation 8:12

"The fourth angel sounded, and a third of the sun and a third of the moon and a third of the stars were struck," -1/3 – blacked out.

Luke 21:25-26

God brought 3 days of darkness in Egypt – Exodus 10:21-23.

Food growth

Temperature change

Human lifestyles

Food is destroyed; distribution is crippled; water supply is limited; production is hampered.

Matthew 24:22

Reverse Order – Revelation 16:8-9 – Sun will scorch men.

The light of the sun, moon, and the stars; This is recorded in Scripture to remind us of God's power, sovereignty and wisdom. Psalm 19:1-6

Romans 1:20

Revelation 8:13 – "Then I looked, and I heard an eagle" – some translations say "angel"; Revelation 4:7 – "eagle"

"to those who dwell on the earth" – "earth dwellers"; those who live for the things of this world.

2 Peter 3:9

"Woe, woe, woe" – next three trumpets – Heightened in their degree of Judgments.

1st Woe – Demonic – Revelation 9:1-11

2nd Woe – Euphrates, Horseman and Hosts – Revelation 9:13-21

 3^{rd} Woe – The handing over of the earth to Beast-worship – Revelation 13

Lesson: We take for granted the creation of the stars, the sun and moon.

Application:

- 1. Let Us Thank God For The Trees, Plants, Food, And Air That God Has Graciously Blessed Us With.
- 2. Let Us Thank God For The Blessings Of The Oceans And Seas; God's Provision Of Transportation By The Ships Of Needed Materials.
- 3. Let Us Thank God For Fresh Water, Rivers And Springs Which Are Nessasary To Sustain Life.
- 4. Let Us Thank God For The Light Of The Sun, Moon And Stars. These are Recorded In Scripture To Remind Us Of God's Power, Sovereignty And Wisdom.
