"The Fruitful Father" Galatians 5:22-23 Fathers Day June 18, 2017

God Places Great Importance Upon Fathers! Fathers are God's Spiritual Representatives in the Home/Society! Matthew 6:9 – God is called our Father, and God has given that earthly role to Earthly Fathers.

Modeling before the family godly character, love, and God's care.

Dad, our children are watching our <u>Actions</u> and <u>Attitudes</u>.

"Men, on this <u>Father's Day, we too are under siege, being lied to</u>!" Society advocates a freedom apart from Jesus which is actually bondage!

Hedonism – "Pleasure is the chief end of man."

Holy Spirit – Is mentioned **7X** in **Galatians 5.**

Thought Of Our Passage: True Freedom Comes Through Faith In Jesus Christ, But Continued Freedom Comes Through Surrender To The Holy Spirit.

Paul Identifies 9 Characteristics of The Fruitful Believer:

Galatians 5:22

But Paul shows a contrast. Galatians 5:19-21 Is "The Works of the Flesh."

Contrasting between the Flesh versus the Spirit:

Works of the Flesh – Have their source in the old nature. Fruit of the Spirit – Fruit has its source in the Holy Spirit. Works of the Flesh – Flesh shows what a man can do. Fruit of the Spirit – What God can do through a man.

Galatians 5:22-23 – Paul speaks about "The Fruit Of The Spirit"; the fruit singular not plural. The Holy Spirit produces one fruit; this fruit has 9 facets or qualities.

"of the Spirit" - is John 15:5.

There seems to be 3 Categories for these 9 Characteristics of fruit:

1. Attitude God-ward - "love, joy, peace,"

"love," – A Christian's first love is God. "joy," – His chief joy in God. "peace," – His deepest peace comes from God.

- **2. Attitude Man-ward –** "patience," is longsuffering towards those who aggravate or persecute us. "kindness," this is a disposition goodness, words and deeds.
- **3. Attitude Self-ward** "faithfulness," this speaks of the reliability of a Christian man. "gentleness," speaks of meekness, which Christ exhibited. "self-control" self-mastery; speaks of faithfulness and gentleness.

Attitude Towards God -

1. Love – Greek "Agape" – "it is a divine love that comes from God and cannot be experienced apart from God; it is a deliberate choice to love, not based on performance or feelings." A Christian's first love is God, that is the source of love. 1 John 4:8

A true child of God is to manifest this same love: Ephesians 5:1-2; Colossians 3:19-21.

Fathers, a relationship with God and yielding to the Holy Spirit will allow us to experience this fruit.

2. Joy – His chief joy in God. Now when we speak of joy, we are not implying that it is the absence of trials. Hebrews 12:2

James 1:2 – "Consider" (count); This word comes as an accounting term. It means "to evaluate"; it is an honest assessment of the figure. It is looking at the hardship from a heavenly or spiritual perspective (That is producing something of value).

God wants us to respond with out minds not our emotions.

Hebrews 12:11

Our Values Determine Our Evaluation.

If I am living for Comfort, my trials will upset me.

If I am living for Godly Character, honoring God, then I can enlist my trials.

Colossians 3:23

3. Peace – His deepest peace comes from God. **Peace** – "inner calmness of emotions and thoughts which rests on the assurance that God is too good to be unkind and too wise to make mistakes"

Peace With God - Romans 5:1

Peace Of God – Philippians 4:7; Colossians 3:15

Attitude Man-ward -

4. Patience – literally "wrath that is put far away"; is longsuffering towards those who aggravate or persecute us.

Colossians 3:13

Fathers, only by yielding to the Holy Spirit can we be long fused.

5. Kindness – "grace in action"; it is the act of kindness toward your enemies.

God demonstrates this towards sinners. Titus 3:4-5

Patience holds back vengeance, gentleness bestows mercy. This is positive, it is actions towards others.

6. Goodness – "uprightness of the soul that hates evil and refrains from doing it."

Romans 3:12

Attitude Self-ward -

7. Faithfulness – "loyalty, the character of one who can be relied on, of one who keeps his promises." It is the belief and faith in God that shows in behavior.

When a person loves God, he believes His promises. 1 Corinthians 13:7

1 Comments 15.7

When a person believes God, he will be faithful to Him. Titus 2:10

Romans 10:17

Fathers, our words and actions reveal our faith in Jesus Christ.

Galatians 5:23

8. Gentleness – (Meekness) Meekness is not weakness! "It is great power under control." Moses, Paul, Jesus were all meek!

Gentleness - Opposite of Defiance - Matthew 5:5

- **9. Self-control temperance –** "mature steadfastness of restraining passions and appetites, not easily influenced by the world, the flesh and the devil."
 - 1 Corinthians 9:25; Romans 7:18

"is no law" – there is no need to curb the actions of a person that is Spirit-led.

Application:

- 1. God's Man Lives To Honor God And Enlist His Trials To Grow In Godly Character. If I Am Living For Comfort, My Trials Will Upset Me.
- 2. True Freedom Comes Through Faith In Jesus Christ, But Continued Freedom Comes Through Surrender To The Holy Spirit.
- 3. Faithfulness "loyalty, the character of one who can be relied on, of one who keeps his promises." Fathers, Our Words And Actions Reveal Our Faith In Jesus Christ.

John R.W. Stott said, "It is not enough to yield passively to the Spirit's control; we must also walk actively in the Spirit's way. Only so will the fruit of the Spirit appear."
