Dan 9:24 "Seventy weeks

"week" means "*a week of years," or seven years."* Seventy sevens would equal 490 years. But this period of 490 years is broken up into three parts:

- 1. During seven weeks (49 years), the city of Jerusalem would be rebuilt and the worship reestablished. 445 B.C. by Cyrus (2 Chron. 36:22-23; Ezra 1).
- 2. After 63 weeks (434 years), Messiah would come to Jerusalem and die for the sins of the world.
- 3. The prince will make an agreement with the Jews for one week (seven years) to protect them from their enemies.
