#### Series "Behold Your King" "The King Is Coming" Matthew 21:1-11 Part-90

This passage must be important because it is recorded in all four gospels. Matt 21:1-11; Mark 11:1-10; Luke 19:29-38; John 12:12-19

## Jesus does two things:

- 1. To Announce Jesus as the King, appealing to Israel to join His Spiritual not Political Kingdom (Fulfilling Bible Prophecy)
- 2. To force the people to make a decision for or against Him, and to force the religious to deliver Jesus to the cross
- 1. Verses 1-3 Jesus' Example of Perfect Knowledge
- 2. Verses 4-5 Jesus' Example of Fulfilling Scripture
- 3. Verses 6-11 Jesus' Example of Obedience to God

## 1. Verses 1-3 – Jesus' Example of Perfect Knowledge:

Jerusalem means "city of peace" or "foundation of peace"

"...and had come to Bethphage" - (No longer exists) "House of Figs."

Donkey – which is full grown, it was female.

Matthew used at least 129 quotations or allusions to the Old Testament in this Gospel.

## 3. Verses 6-11 – Jesus' Example of Obedience to God:

There were three different groups in the crowd that day:

- 1. The Passover visitors from outside Judea (John 12:12, 18)
- 2. The local people who had witnessed the raising of Lazarus (John 12:17)
- The religious leaders who were greatly concerned about what Jesus might do at the feast (John 12:19)

"Hosanna - Means "save now!", "save we pray!", "grant salvation;" it is a petition to save now!

Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord; Literally "The one who comes representing Yahweh, Hosanna in the highest!"; "Praise to Yahweh"

# **Application:**

- Who is Jesus Christ?
- John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but through Me."
- "I am the way, the exclusive way to God. Not <u>a</u> way but <u>The</u> Way!
- "...and the truth," reality, objective truth. There is ultimate reality it is found in the person of Jesus Christ.
- "...and the life." There is no life outside of Jesus Christ.
- "...no one comes to the Father, but through Me."
