"stay on the alert" - 4X in Verses 33, 34, 35, 37

The Thought Of Our Passage: "When Will Jesus Return? The Question Should Really Be How Should We Spend Our Time Until He Returns?"

<u>1. Verses 28-31 – We Know Jesus Will Return</u> <u>2. Verses 32-33 – We Don't Know When Jesus Will Return</u> <u>3. Verses 34-37 – We Should Look For Jesus' Return</u>

1. Verses 28-31 – We Know Jesus Will Return:

Mark 13:28

Mark 13:3 – "He was <u>sitting on the Mount of Olives</u>" – "The Olivet Discourse", Matt 24-25; Mark 13; Luke 21

Mark 13:1-13 – The Final Days Mark 13:14-23 – The Great Tribulation Mark 13:24-27 – The Second Coming Of Jesus

Mark 13:28-37 – The Last Generation: Jesus closed this section of His discourse with 2 practical admonitions: Fig Tree; The Servants Waiting For Their Master.

Verse 28 – Lesson From The Fig Tree: The word learn – "get it, learn this" parable – "cast alongside of"; Illustration alongside of instruction.

Mark 11:13-14 – The Cursing of the Fig Tree

"fig tree" - Hosea 9:10

Luke 21:29 - "Behold the fig tree and all the trees;"

Mark 13:29

"Even so, <u>you</u> too, when you see these things happening," – What things is Jesus referring to? Things just described in verses 14 to 23.

Mark 13:30

"Truly I say to you," – "this is of the truth, this is a trustworthy statement"; "this generation"

Note 4 Different Views:

 The Rebirth Of The Nation Of Israel: "generation" – generally defined as 40 years. Some have suggested that with the event of May 14, 1948, Israel was rebirthed as a Nation. So the suggestion was that Jesus would come within 40 years of 1948.

Luke 21:29 – "Behold the fig tree and all the trees;"

- 2. The Nation Of Israel Will Always Exist: "generation" means "this race"; Israel will never cease to be or exist. Jeremiah 31:35-36
- **3. The Near Fulfillment:** 70 AD The Temple and the city of Jerusalem would be destroyed by the Roman army.
- **4. The Far Fulfillment:** The generation that is alive to see the abomination of desolation, or these events transpiring. Mark 13:24-26

"will not pass away until all these things take place." – Revelation 6-19

Verse 31 – Jesus' Authority: Mark 13:31

2 Peter 3:10-12

"but My words will not pass away." - The Temporal Versus The Eternal.

Isaiah 40:8

Matthew 5:18

Luke 16:17

"When The Bible Speaks, God Speaks!" Jesus' Word is God's Word! His Words are to be heeded and obeyed.

2. Verses 32-33 - We Don't Know When Jesus Will Return:

"But of that day or hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven,"

"nor the Son, but the Father alone."

Mark 13:33

"Take heed," – Beware, perceive. We need to study. We need to understand.

"keep on the alert" - "to lie sleepless, stay awake"

1 Corinthians 15:56-58

"and pray; " – "to pray to God, supplicate, worship, pray earnestly, make prayer"; Not being able to sleep should give way to prayer.

Acts 1:6-7

Titus 2:11-14

"When is the time?" When the question really should be "How should we spend our time profitably?"

3. Verses 34-37 – We Should Look For Jesus' Return:

Mark 13:34

Verse 34 – Lesson Of The Servants Waiting For Their Master: "It is like a man, away on a journey," – This is Jesus' Ascension. Acts 1:9-11

We Are To Be About Our Father's Business: "assigning to each one his task,"

"also commanded the doorkeeper to <u>stay on the alert</u>." – Note: "stay on the alert", Verses 33, 34, 35, 37.

Roman Watch – "whether in the evening (6-9 PM), at midnight (9 PM-12 AM), at cockcrowing (12-3 AM), or in the morning (3-6 AM)."

- 2. This Earth Is Going To Pass Away, So Our Focus Should Be Upon God's Kingdom, Which Is Eternal, And Living For The Spiritual.
