Why all this preparation and secrecy? Judas was looking for an opportunity to betray Jesus

2. Verses 20-25 - The Betrayal:

Between verses 20-21, there is the washing of the disciples feet, including Judas' feet (John 13). There is the disciples arguing over who is the greatest (Luke 22).

- 1. Unleavened bread be ready, lack of corruption.
- 2. Bitter herbs spoke of their bitter oppression in Egypt.
- 3. Salt water spoke of the bitterness of slavery with tears.
- 4. Stewed fruit color and consistency spoke of the mortar that they used in slavery.
- 5. The roasted lamb was to have no broken bones offered whole This spoke of the lamb of God.
- 6. There were 4 cups of wine To remind Israel of 4 promises that God had made. Exodus 6:6, 7
