1. The Two Builders:

Matthew 7:24

"Therefore that takes us back to Matthew 7:21-23 where Jesus comes to the closing statement on commitment.

- 5 Similarities between the wise and the foolish builder.
- 1. Both were hearers.
- 2. Both wanted to build permanent houses.
- 3. Both looked the same.
- 4. Both built by a stream or a place that did flood.
- 5. Both under went the same storm.

Differences:

- 1. One acted upon His Words, the other disobeyed His Words.
- 2. One was called wise, and the other called foolish.

The Wise -

The wise has a faith in God that is demonstrated in obedience to Jesus and His word.

The Foolish – foolish – Greek word moro which we get our English "Moron"

There are a lot of reasons people give for disobedience to Gods Word!

I just don't have the time to build on the rock!

The Teachings of the Bible are too difficult to understand!

The Bible makes me feel uncomfortable!

3. The Two Results:

Verses - 25 and 27 are identical except for the out come. One stood, one fell.

"And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and burst against that house;

Job 5:6-7

Numbers 11

2 Corinthians 1:8-10

The House on the Rock: Matthew 7:25 yet it did not fall, for it had been founded upon the rock.

The House on the Sand: Matthew 7:27 burst against that house; and it fell, and great was its fall."

The Response To The Sermon:

1. Amazed At His Teaching: amazed at His teaching; amazed - Greek Lit – "to be driven out of one's senses by sudden shock, to become speechless, or a loss for words."
