His Works - and these miraculous powers?

Carpenter – Literally "*a builder*" A skilled craft involving construction.

John 6:41-42

James He became a leader in the church in Jerusalem **Gal 1:19**
He also wrote the book of James.

Judas – or Jude who wrote the book of Jude.

Matthew 13:56

This man or literally "*this fellow*" an expression of contempt.
