1. Verses 45-47 - The Faithful Servant:

slave in Greek, doo'-los which is the word Servant. The root word means "to tie in knots, to weave and to bind"

Faithful – "to believe, trustworthy, sure, true". We use the term "Faithful Marriage Partner, Faithful Spouse"

Sensible – "discreet (implying a cautious character), practical skill"

A Faithful Servant Is Faithful Because They Expect His Return:

He is to oversee the Master's household. It is the Master who sets him over His household.
