Series "Our Riches In Christ" "The Walk Of The Husband" Ephesians 5:25-33 Study-21

When you define the two roles of "Submission" and "Love," you could define both terms with the word "Surrender." Submitting and loving are acts of surrender.

This section of **Ephesians 5:18-6:9** is the "Walk of Harmony!"

We need God's power to surrender, so Paul starts with being filled with the Spirit, **Ephesians 5:18.**

Paul reveals 3 evidences of one being filled with the Spirit!

- 1. Evidence Joy: Ephesians 5:19
- 2. Evidence Thankfulness: Ephesians 5:20
- 3. Evidence Submissive: Ephesians 5:21

Thought Of The Passage: "The Spirit-Filled Husband Chooses To Be Submissive To God Through Loving His Wife In Everything."

- 1. Verse 25 Sacrificial Love
- 2. Verses 26-27 Cleansing Love
- 3. Verses 28-30 Caring Love
- 4. Verses 31-33 Lasting Love

1. Verse 25 - Sacrificial Love:

Ephesians 5:25 – "love your wives" – whatever it means, Paul says it 3X's that we are to love:

Verse 25 - "love your wives"

Verse 28 – "so husbands ought also to love their own wives"

Verse 33 - "let each individual among you also love his own wife."

"love" – in English, there is one word – we use it for everything...

The Bible has a lot to say about love; "Love" occurs at least 650X.

<u>In the Greek language, there are 4 different words for love:</u>

1. <u>Eros</u> – not used in the Bible. Sexual love – eros – erotic – it's a receiving love, not giving.

- **2.** <u>Storgee</u> Not used in the Bible. Family love Sisterly/brotherly/parental.
- **3.** <u>Phileo</u> Human love. Affection brotherly love affection human love. (We get Philadelphia, the city of brotherly love)
- **4. Agape** "a divine love, that of a spiritual plane experienced only through conversion through a new nature, an unconditional love Not based upon performance, excellency, true worth, but a love that is a deliberate choice made without assignable cause except that which lies in the nature of God Himself." Not Emotion But Motion Paul says nothing about emotions! It's a command a love based on the new nature.

"just as Christ also loved the Church and gave Himself up for her" – Sacrificial love – only possible for Christians.

Love Sacrificially – Sacrificing will stop us from being embittered against our wives – not expecting anything in return, Colossians 3:19.

John 15:13; 1 Peter 3:7

"live with your wives" – KJV, dwell; literally, "make togetherness, settle down, love the home."

"in an understanding way" – "Intelligent recognition of the marriage relationship;" Spending time finding out her moods, goals, fears, hopes and needs.

"show her honor" – Grant honor, assign to, portion out, to dispense, courtesy, respect, kindness. "as with a weaker vessel, since she is a woman" – This is not referring to the wife as being gender inferior to man.

"weaker vessel" – "not as strong, delicate;" term "vessel" – used by priest in the temple for ministry; wife needs to be looked at as delicate, dedicated to God!

"grant her honor" – "grant" – to assign to, to portion off. "honor" – precious, courtesy, respect, kindness.

"a fellow heir of the grace of life" - wives are on the husband's team.

"so that your prayers may not be hindered." – Just as a wife cannot serve God apart from submitting to her husband, so neither can the husband.

2. Verses 26-27 - Cleansing Love:

Ephesians 5:26 – "sanctify" – "to set apart, to be holy, sacred, special use." "sanctify her" – this is a priestly duty – husband needs to be the priest of the home.

"having cleansed her by the washing of water with the Word." – The term "Word" – is speaking about the spoken Word.

Ephesians 5:27 – "that He might present to Himself" – to the Lord; Jesus presenting His church.

"the church" – wife – "in all her glory" – Husband should not drag his bride down to the gutter.

"having no spot" – "caused by defilement on the outside."

"or wrinkle" – "caused by decay, this comes from the inside."

2 Corinthians 3:18; Jude 24

"she would be holy and blameless" - How is your wife looking today?

3. Verses 28-30 - Caring Love:

Ephesians 5:28 – "So" – in light of the fact that the husband is a priest, sacrificing for her.

"husbands ought also to love their own wives" – the word "ought" – "owe, to be a debtor" ...not emotion ...we owe ...we owe the debt to love to our wife.

"as their own bodies" – <u>same degree</u>, or it is <u>the same thing</u> when you love your wife.

Ephesians 5:29 – Note – "for no one ever hated his own flesh"

"but nourishes" – "to feed physically, to provide for;" we pamper ourselves, 1 Timothy 5:8.

"cherishes it" – "to soften or warm with body heat;" Bird to keep young warm.

"Just as Christ also does the church" – Ephesians 4:8 – Jesus gives gifts.

Ephesians 5:30; 1 Corinthians 12:12-13

Genesis 2:21-23

Adam – gave <u>part</u> of himself for his bride – "<u>He took one of his ribs</u>" **Christ** – gave <u>all</u> for us.

4. Verses 31-33 - Lasting Love:

Ephesians 5:31 – Paul quotes Genesis 2:24.

"FOR THIS REASON" - What reason? Jesus gave His all for us, His bride.

Marriage In God's Divine Plan Contains 3 Non-Negotiable Parts:

- **1. Severance –** "A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER" "leave" a man must leave in order to lead. The Marriage Now Becomes The Primary Relationship!
- **2. Permanence** "AND SHALL BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE," speaks "to glue, the melting together, inseparable bond." Men Need To Be Permanently Glued To Your Wife.
- **3. Unity –** "AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH." God takes two people and makes them one, Hebrews 13:4.

Ephesians 5:32 – "This mystery is great;" – Church in Ephesians as a "Body," "Temple," now as a "Bride."

Ephesians 5:33 – Husband – "love his own wife even as himself" – If you are not helping, you are not directing, you are not loving your wife!

"the wife must see to it that she respects her husband." - "reverence"

Application:

- 1. Sacrificial Love Jesus Modeled The Love That The Husband Is To Have towards His Wife As Giving His All For Her.
- Cleansing Love Husbands Have A Sacred Responsibility To Protect Their Wives From Anything That Could Bring Outward And Inward Corruption.
- 3. Caring Love Husbands Are To Love Their Wives To The Same Degree That They Love Themselves.
- 4. Lasting Love Husband's Love For His Wife Must Be His Primary Love Relationship; A Relationship That Is Permanent And A Unity That Is Nothing Short Of Miraculous.
