## 1. Verses 33-41 – The Vineyard:

Context of the parables: Matt 21:23

1. The Two Sons – Matt 21:28-32

- 2. The Vineyard Parable Matt 21:33-44
- 3. The Marriage Feast Matt 22:1-14

Parable - made up of two words: "Para"- alongside and "Ballo" - to throw or cast. So, "to cast alongside of".

There was a landowner - This owner is God their Father

Isa 5:1-7

Psalm 80:8-10

and put a wall around it (Protection)

and dug a wine press in it (Provision)

and built a tower (Precaution)

Truths to Remember: The God-given privileges that are ours!

and rented it out to vine-growers (Purpose)

vine-growers were the religious leaders

Truths to Remember: The God-given abundant allocation!

Truths to Remember: The justice of the judgment of God!

#### 2. Verses 42-44 – The Cornerstone:

Psalm 118:22-23

The stone - God is referred to as a rock or a stone - Deut. 32:4, 18, 30-31; Ps. 18:2, 31, 46

Jesus was both the foundation stone and the cornerstone – 1 Cor 3:11; Eph 2:20-22; 1 Peter 2:4-5

Jesus was a stumbling stone - Isa. 8:14-15; Rom. 9:32-33; 1 Cor. 1:23

The Second Coming - Jesus will be a smiting stone of destruction – Dan 2:34

The "builders", Jewish religious leaders - Acts 4:11

REJECTED – Literally "to reject after investigation"

Matt 21:43-44

We have two options before us:

- 1. Humble yourselves and receive Jesus as Savior. He who falls on this stone will be broken to pieces.
- 2. Receive Jesus as your judge when you stand before Him on the final day. Whomever it falls, it will scatter him like dust."

Truths to Remember: God's love knows no limits!
