Matt 2:1-12

Herod – Opposed The King!

Religious Leaders & Citizens of Jerusalem – Ignored The King!

The Magi – <u>Seek The King</u>! "Seeking The Christ of Christmas!"

<u>1. Verses 1-10 – The Wise Seek Him</u> 2. Verses 11-12 – The Wise Worship Him

1. Verses 1-10 – The Wise Seek Him:

Matthew 2:1

Matthew 1 – covers Jesus' lineage (His right to the throne).

"after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea" – Luke 2:1-20 gives details.

"in the days of Herod the king," – Herod: He reigned for 33 years, 37 BC to 4 BC.

Magi – Our modern word "magistrate" is derived from the word Magi; highly educated scholars who were trained in medicine, history, religion, prophecy and astronomy.

Matthew 2:2

"Where is He who has been born King of the Jews?" - Isa 9:6-7, Daniel 9

These Wise Men, Magi, who were scientists, did not see a conflict between Science and Scripture! God wants us to <u>worship Him with our minds</u>.

Albert Einstein said, "Science without religion is lame. Religion without science is blind."

"For we saw His star in the east," - Num. 24:17

"in the east," – (Babylon or Persia) at least 1000 miles.

Have you noticed how many passages in the Bible encourage us to seek God and promise that we will find Him?

Isa. 55:6-7

Jer. 29:13

Zeph. 2:3

Amos 5:6

Matt. 7:7-8

God tells us to seek Him because He is accessible to us. God is not hard to find and is not hiding from us.

Matthew 2:3

"he was troubled," - Literally "agitated"; "and all Jerusalem with him."

Matthew 2:4-5

"Bethlehem" - "House of bread"

John 6:35

From Jerusalem to Bethlehem is about 5 miles South! (What good is Bible prophecy if it does not lead to action?)

Matthew 2:6

700-year-old prophecy Micah 5:2 – Religious leaders <u>interpreted this</u> passage as literal. He was an individual, not the nation.

Matthew 2:7

Matthew 2:16

Matthew 2:8-9

"until it came and stood over where the Child was." – How does a star stand over a house? "By God!"

Matthew 2:10

2. Verses 11-12 – The Wise Worship Him:

Matthew 2:11

"And they came into the <u>house</u>" – a house, not a stable.

"and saw the <u>Child</u> with Mary His mother;" – Note, Child – "little child"; 1 to 2 years of age.

"and they fell down and worshiped Him;" – Worship – "to fall upon the knees and touch the ground with the forehead as an expression of profound reverence."

Gold – Deity Of Jesus; Gold, most precious of metals, a gift fit for a King (Matthew's Gospel – Jesus the King). Jesus is the King of Kings.

Frankincense – Ministry of Jesus used by the priest in sacrifice. Jesus is our High Priest. Jesus' life was a sweet fragrance to God. He lived a perfect life.

Myrrh – Humanity of Jesus; used to embalm the dead. Jesus is the lamb scarified before the foundation of the world.

Matthew 2:12

Application:

- 1. God Encourages Us To Seek Him Because He Is Accessible To All. God Is Not Difficult To Find If We Will Seek Him With All Of Our Heart: Jer. 29:13.
- 2. The Wise Men Teach Us That True Wisdom Is Not Based Upon One's IQ Nor Education, But One's Actions To Seek And Worship Jesus: Isa. 55:6.
