"Worldliness" — "is a preoccupation with or interest in the temporal system of life that places anything perishable before that which is eternal."

"Revelation" – to unveil – to uncover – to see Jesus Christ and His plan for eternity.

Key Verse Of Revelation: Revelation 1:19 – the book has 3 parts:

- **1. Things which you have seen –** Rev. 1: Vision of the coming of Jesus
- **2. The things which are –** Rev. 2-3: 7 Churches
- 3. The Things which shall take place after these things Rev. 4-22

Thought Of Our Passage: Jesus Stands In Opposition To Worldliness As The Sharp Two-Edged Sword, The Ultimate And Final Authority.

- 1. Verses 12 Author
- 2. Verse 13 Approval
- 3. Verses 14-15 Accusation
- 4. Verses 16-17 Admonition

1. Verses 12 - Author:

Revelation 2:12 – "And to the angel" – Angolos – Messenger – Minister; Revelation 1:20 – Pastor of the church.

"Pergamum" – Per – means "opposition"; gamos – means "marriage"; means "Objectionable Marriage".

(Map) Pergamum The City – today called "Bergama"; 100 miles north of Ephesus, 60 miles north of Smyrna, 15 miles from the sea.

Called "Foremost City of Asia Minor".

Pergamum, A Center for Emperor Worship – Temple made for Augustus Caesar.

~ Temple of Athena – Altar of Zeus.

Temple of the god Asclepius (the savior), whose emblem was the serpent on a staff; Genesis 3 – Satan.

"The One who has the sharp two-edged sword says this" – This is none other than Jesus Christ Himself. Revelation 1:16

"two-edged sword" - symbol of the Word of God, assurance, authority of judgment on the basis of absolute truth. First Negative introduction of Jesus.

Hebrews 4:12

Revelation 19:15

Church History— 313-606 AD, The Church Married To The World.

Constantine: Was a ruler in Rome. He succeeded over 2 other rulers and became Emperor – the sole Ruler. 306-337 AD

Constantine wanted a unified kingdom:

- ~ 311: Edict permitting limited toleration for Christians.
- ~ 313: Had victory by battle proclaimed his conversion.

Issued Edict of Milan – 313 AD, that put a stop to 250 years of persecution.

Nicene Creed – 325 AD, Trinity proclaimed, the deity/humanity of Jesus Christ.

2. Verse 13 - Approval:

Revelation 2:13

"I know" – This is said 7X – each time to the 7 churches; God knows all about you this morning – your condition.

(K.J.V.) "your works" – Jesus saw their works; "and where you dwell" – "Permanent resident".

"where Satan's throne is" – "a seat of special authority, seat of judge or king". Pagan Pergamum's worship either of the Roman emperor, or Greek gods in the temple of Zeus, the god of healing.

Hell is not Satan's throne. Revelation 12:7-10

John 16:11 – Ruler of this world.

2 Corinthians 4:4 – god of this world.

Ephesians 2:2 – Prince of the power of the air.

1 John 5:19 – lies in the power of the evil one.

Loyal To Their Conviction Of God: "you hold fast my name" – Firm conviction – Jesus is Lord – Master – Messiah.

Loyal To The Practice Of Faith: "did not deny My faith" – This takes us a step further, personally exercising your faith in Jesus Christ.

1 John 2:3-6

"even in the days of Antipas" – means "likeness of his father".

"My witness" – the word means – "martyr".

"My faithful one" - Jesus gave him his own title, Revelation 1:5.

3. Verses 14-15 - Accusation:

Revelation 2:14

"who hold the teaching of Balaam." – (Numbers 22-25)

"Balaam" – a gentile prophet, he was a man with a grasp on truth, knowledge of God's character.

Balaam Taught Worldliness; Every man has his price – "who kept teaching Balak"

Balaam Taught How To Use God's Holiness For Evil Ends – "to put a stumbling block before the sons of Israel," – Numbers 25; 31:16.

Balaam Taught The Worship Of The World – "to eat things sacrificed to idols," – (24,000 died in judgment)

Acts 15:29

"and to commit acts of immorality." - 1 Peter 4:3-4

2 Peter 2:15-16

Revelation 2:15

"Hold" - "To grasp, or grip"

"the teaching of the Nicolaitans" - Revelation 2:6

Nikao – To Conquer; laos – people = or Clergy over laity.

4. Verses 16-17 - Admonition:

Revelation 2:16

"Repent" – God's remedy for sin – Change of mind – produces change of attitude.

John 12:47-48

"make war against them with the sword of my mouth." – Revelation 1:16

Balaam killed with the sword, Numbers 31:8.

John 12:48

Revelation 2:17

Jesus gives 3 promises to the overcomer:

- Promise "To him who overcomes, to him I will give some of the hidden manna" – (forsaking idols and sacrifices) The manna was hidden in the Ark of the covenant, Exodus 16:32-34; Hebrews 9:4.
- 2. Promise "I will give him a white stone"
- 3. Promise "And a new (different) name written on the stone which no one knows but he who receives it." Revelation 3:12 The self-revelation of Jesus.

Application:

- 1. Love For The Truth We Must Love Truth And Let It Be The Final Authority In Our Lives.
- 2. Desire For Holiness In Order To Win A Lost World, It Can't Be Done Through Worldliness. Without Integrity, The World Won't Listen To Us.
- 3. Willingness To Repent Jesus Called The Church Caught Up In Compromise To Repent.
