Jesus shows six ways that our righteousness can exceed that of the scribes and Pharisees.

Each one starts with the phrase: "You have heard." 6 X's

Jesus then says to the people - "But I say to you" 7 X's

Marriage God's Design: • Gen 2:21-25

4 Essentials Which Constitutes A Biblical Marriage:

- 1. (Severance) A man shall leave his father and mother
- 2. (**Permanence**) and shall cleave to his wife cleave speaks of "to glue, melting of joints together, inseparable bond."
- 3. (Unity) and they shall become one flesh -
 - Eph. 5:31 and the two shall become one flesh.
- 4. (**Intimacy**) Gen 2:25

2. Marriage During Moses Day:

• Deut 24:1-4

Deut 24:1 - some indecency - (• Lev. 20:10)

indecency - literally "nakedness, impurity"

Process: Four Steps - Deut. 24:1-4

- 1. **Found some indecency** some grounds
- 2. **Writes a certificate** take time, would probably require a Levite to write it out.
- 3. **Serve it** place it in person's hand
- 4. Sent out of the house
- Mal 2:13-16

Jesus gives in the next 3 verses 7 Things About Marriage:

- 1. **Divine Institution** (Created) God made marriage before the church, govt.
- 2. Marriage consist of (**Male and Female**) Monogamist Relationship
 - Matt 19:5
- 3. Marriage Involves **Leaving** starting a new unit
- 4. Marriage Is **Permanent** (cleave) Lit. "to glue together" melt together. PVC pipe melted together
- 5. Marriage Involves **Consummation** One flesh sexual union
 - Matt 19:6
- 6. Marriage Is The **Highest Of All Relationships** above children, friends (no longer two)
- 7. Marriage Is **Non-Divisible** "Let no man separate" no divorce no option inseparable
 - Matt 19:7-9

4. Marriage God's True Intent:

• Matt 5:31

Taken Deut. 24:1-4 Religious Leaders - were concerned about two things:

- 1. **The grounds of Divorce** Don't commit adultery just divorce your spouse
- 2. **Procedure** Letter of the law not the spirit of intent How to get out and the right way

• Matt 5:32
