We're looking at The Sermon on The Mount, Matthew 5-7 We're looking at the section called The Beatitudes Matthew 5:3-12

**Beatitudes** - means "have these attitudes"...beautiful attitudes (not DO-Attitudes)

These describe the character traits and qualities of those who belong to Christ's kingdom.

**This sermon was addressed to Disciples** – "learners, pupils, followers of the teacher and teachings"

 $\boldsymbol{\sim}$  This sermon is not a new standard by which a man can be saved!

This sermon does not replace the Ten Commandments
This sermon is impossible to fulfill thru human resources
You must be: Born again

"Blessed" "Oh how happy.....To be envied...happiness" This word was used of Greek gods that alone were said to have possessed a joy and happiness that could only be enjoyed in

### the divine.

Blessed (divine happiness) is God's blessing and approval upon us, Literally "The applause of heaven" a result of God Himself being pleased with us. That if we truly want God, if we truly want the spiritual than these beatitudes are for us.

# Who Are The Blessed? Those that God approves, heaven applauds.

### **Beatitudes 1-4 Our Response to God:**

- 1# Beatitude is "Blessed is the Poor in spirit"
- 2# Beatitude is "Blessed are those who mourn"
- 3# Beatitude is "Blessed are the gentle"
- 4# Beatitude is "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness"

### 8 Things That Being Pure is Not!

1. This does NOT mean pure in ceremony

2. This does NOT refer to pure in mind in regards to education, learning..... you can see God

- 3. It does NOT mean pure in morals: Rom. 2:1-16
- 4. It's NOT talking about pure in health & wealth
- 5. It is NOT speaking of being pure by birth
- 6. This is NOT speaking about being pure in conduct
- 7. It's NOT a reference to pure in schedule

- 8. It's is NOT referring to pure in experience
- Matt 5:8
- Psalms 24:3-4

**Pure** – has two different meanings First, it means "to make pure by cleansing from dirt, filth, or contamination" and was most often used to describe metals that had been "refined by fire until they were free from impurities." It was also used for "soiled clothes that had been washed clean," and of "grain that had been carefully sifted to remove all impurities."

# The word sincere, integrity, non hypocritical. "A sculpture – sincere and pure, would chip and produce a statue without wax"

Second, it refers to being **"unmixed, as having no double allegiance."** The basic idea is that of "integrity, singleness of heart, as opposed to duplicity, or a divided heart."

pure in heart, "A person with a passion for purity is one who has been cleansed in character so that the way he or she looks in public is the way he or she is in private."

In the Bible, the heart - represents "the deepest emotions and also the mind and the will. It is a comprehensive term that refers to the whole person."
